## For An Act To Be Entitled

9 AN ACT TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING SAMPLE BALLOTS; TO  
10 ALLOW VOLUMINOUS NUMBERS OF SAMPLE BALLOTS TO BE MADE  
11 AVAILABLE TO THE PUBLIC BY OTHER MEANS; AND FOR OTHER  
12 PURPOSES.

16 TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING SAMPLE  
17 BALLOTS; AND TO ALLOW VOLUMINOUS NUMBERS  
18 OF SAMPLE BALLOTS TO BE MADE AVAILABLE TO  
19 THE PUBLIC BY OTHER MEANS.

22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
23

24 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 7-5-202(c), concerning the posting of  
25 sample ballots at the polling place, is amended to read as follows:

26 (c)(1) On the day of any election, the following shall be posted at  
27 each polling site and remain posted continuously therein until the polls  
28 close:

29 ~~(1)(A)~~ The public notice required in subsection (a) of  
30 this section;

31 ~~(2)(B)(i)~~ At least two (2) sample ballots, marked with the  
32 word "SAMPLE", of each ballot style that will be used at the polling site;

33 ~~(3)(ii)~~ If the polling site has more than fifteen  
34 (15) ballot styles and has posted a sample ballot for each ballot style via  
35 an internet website before the beginning of early voting, the polling site  
36 may provide the following in lieu of the sample ballots under subdivision



1 (c)(1)(B)(i) of this section:

2 (a) At least two (2) bound volumes that include each  
3 sample ballot, marked with the word "SAMPLE"; or

4 (b) At least two (2) electronic devices that allow  
5 voters to access a sample ballot for each ballot style;

6 (C) Two (2) copies of the full text of all measures on the  
7 ballot;

8 ~~(4)~~(D) At least two (2) copies of instructions on how to  
9 vote, including how to cast a provisional ballot and instructions for fail-  
10 safe voting;

11 ~~(5)~~(E) General information on voting rights under  
12 applicable federal and state laws, including information on the right of an  
13 individual to cast a provisional ballot and instructions on how to contact  
14 the appropriate officials if these rights are alleged to have been violated;

15 ~~(6)~~(F) General information on federal and state laws  
16 regarding prohibitions on acts of fraud and misrepresentation;

17 ~~(7)~~(A)(G)(i) Double-sided signs containing the words "VOTE  
18 HERE".

19 ~~(B)~~(ii) Each sign shall be at least two feet ~~(2')~~ by  
20 two feet ~~(2')~~ (2' x 2') in size and shall contain an arrow pointing to the  
21 polling site.

22 ~~(C)~~(iii) A sign shall be posted near each main  
23 driveway entrance to the polling site on each public street bordering the  
24 polling site so as to be visible to all traffic approaching the polling site.

25 ~~(D)~~(iv) The sign shall be as close as possible to  
26 the public street without obstructing traffic; and

27 ~~(8)~~(H) One (1) printout from each voting machine,  
28 terminal, or ballot tabulator showing whether the candidate and question  
29 counters register zero (0).

30 (2) If a county is providing sample ballots for a specified  
31 polling site in bound volumes or electronic databases under subdivision  
32 (c)(1)(B)(ii) of this section, the county shall ensure the bound volumes or  
33 electronic databases are organized so that a voter may easily identify the  
34 sample ballot corresponding with his or her precinct-part.
