18	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

20	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 14-42-206(a), concerning nominating
21	petitions for municipal elections, is amended to read as follows:
22	(a)(1) The city or town council of any city or town with the mayor-
23	council form of government, shall determine by resolution passed before
24	January l of the year of the election, may whether to request the county
25	party committees of recognized political parties under the laws of the state
26	to conduct party primaries for municipal offices for the forthcoming year.
27	(2) The resolution shall remain in effect for the subsequent
28	elections unless revoked by the city or town council.
29	$\frac{(3)}{(2)}$ When <u>If</u> the resolution has been adopted <u>in the</u>
30	<u>affirmative</u> , the clerk or recorder shall mail a certified copy of the
31	resolution to the chairs of the county party committees and to the chairs of
32	the state party committees.
33	(4)(3) Candidates nominated for municipal office by political
34	primaries under this section shall be certified by the county party
35	committees to the county board of election commissioners and shall be placed
36	on the ballot at the general election.
