33	3 (a) There is established the Arkansas Council of He	<u>ealthcare</u>

3	(3) Two (2) members of the community to be appointed by the

28	17-80-503. Powers and duties.	
29	The Arkansas Council of Healthcare Professions shall:	
30	(1) Evaluate and provide recommendations to the General Assembly	
31	regarding requests received by the council from:	
32	(A) Practitioners seeking to establish new healthcare	
33	professions to be licensed in the state or to establish separate regulatory	
34	entities; and	
35	(B) Healthcare professionals seeking to expand or narrow	
36	the scope of practice of a healthcare profession;	

1	(2) Evaluate requests received under subdivision (1) of this	
2	section based on objective criteria to determine whether the practitioners or	
3	healthcare professionals have the requisite knowledge, training, experience,	
4	and skills to provide the proposed care;	
5	(3) Examine:

7	of this section on public health and safety;	
8	(B) The economic impact on overall healthcare delivery;	
9	(C) Whether the potential benefits of the request outweigh

20	17-80-504. Requests.	
21	(a) On or before July 1 of each even-numbered year, a practitioner or	
22	healthcare professional may submit a written request to the Arkansas Council	
23	of Healthcare Professions under § 17-80-503(1) that includes:	
24	(1) A description of the request written in plain language;	
25	(2) Empirical information regarding the factors to be examined	
26	by the council, including information about the locations in which	
27	practitioners are currently practicing, the percent of practice time spent in	
28	those locations, the types of patients served, and the reimbursement received	
29	<pre>for services;</pre>	
30	(3) A summary of current state laws and rules governing the	
31	<pre>profession, if any;</pre>	
32	(4) Current education and training requirements for the	
33	<pre>profession;</pre>	
34	(5) A history of the scope of practice changes requested or	
35	enacted, or both, for the profession;	
36	(6) Information regarding the numbers and types of complaints,	

T	licensure actions, and maipractice claims against the profession, if any;
2	(7) Regional and national trends in the profession; and
3	(8) A summary of relevant practices in other states.
4	(b) On or before September 1 of each even-numbered year, a
5	practitioner who opposes a request may submit a written response to the
6	council that indicated the specific reasons for opposing the request.
7	(c) For each request submitted under § 17-80-503(1), the council shall
8	appoint a subcommittee composed of the following members:
9	(1) One (1) member of the profession seeking new licensure, a
10	new regulatory entity, or a modification in scope of practice;
11	(2) One (1) member of the profession impacted by, or directly in
12	opposition to, the proposed new licensure, new regulatory entity, or
13	modification in scope of practice;
14	(3) One (1) member who is neither directly or indirectly
15	impacted by the proposed new licensure, new regulatory entity, or
16	modification in scope of practice;
17	(4) The Surgeon General; and
18	(5) One (1) member of the community.
19	(d) The council may requestan academic institutions to assist with
20	analysis of submitted requests.
21	
22	17-80-505. Reporting.
23	On or before October 31, 2020, the Arkansas Council of Healthcare
24	Professions shall submit to the General Assembly a report detailing:
25	(1) Gaps in data that would assist with deliberations by the
26	<pre>council;</pre>
27	(2) Data that should be collected by healthcare professional
28	licensing entities to address information gaps; and
29	(3) Available data sources that would provide meaningful
30	information for deliberations by the council.
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
