- 1 (7)(A) The person is a certified law enforcement officer, either 2 on-duty or off-duty.
- (B) If the person is an off-duty certified law enforcement
 officer, he or she may be required by a public school or publicly supported
 institution of higher education to be in physical possession of a valid
 identification identifying the person as a certified law enforcement officer;

- SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 5-73-122(a)(1) and (2), concerning the permissibility of a certified law enforcement officer to carry a firearm in a publicly owned building or facility, are amended to read as follows:
- (a)(1) Except as provided in § 5-73-322, § 5-73-306(5), § 16-21-147, and this section, it is unlawful for any a person other than a certified law enforcement officer, either on-duty or off-duty, or a security guard in the employ of the state or an agency of the state, or any city or county, or any state or federal military personnel, to knowingly carry or possess a loaded firearm or other deadly weapon in any publicly owned building or facility or on the State Capitol grounds.
- enforcement officer, either on-duty or off-duty, or a security guard in the employ of the state or an agency of the state, or any city or county, or any state or federal military personnel, to knowingly carry or possess a firearm, whether loaded or unloaded, in the State Capitol Building or the Arkansas Justice Building in Little Rock.

- SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 5-73-122(b), concerning the permissibility of a certified law enforcement officer to carry a handgun in a courtroom, is amended to read as follows:
- (b) However, a <u>certified</u> law enforcement officer, <u>either on-duty or off-duty</u>, officer of the court, bailiff, or any other person authorized by the court is permitted to possess a handgun in the courtroom of any court or a courthouse of this state.

- 33 SECTION 5. Arkansas Code § 5-73-122, concerning carrying a firearm in 34 a publicly owned building or facility, is amended to add additional 35 subsections to read as follows:
 - (d) An off-duty certified law enforcement officer carrying a firearm
