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22	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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24	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 24-2-504(a), concerning the return to
25	covered employment by military personnel, is amended to read as follows:
26	(a) An active member of the state retirement system who is called to
27	active military duty <u>or state active military duty</u> shall be afforded all
28	employment protections as provided in the Uniformed Services Employment and
29	Reemployment Rights Act, 38 U.S.C. § 4301 et seq., as in effect on January 1,
30	2009.
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32	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 24-2-505(a)(1), concerning compliance with
33	the Heroes Earnings Assistance and Relief Tax Act of 2008, is amended to read
34	as follows:
35	(a)(1) In the case of a member who dies while performing qualified
36	military service, including state active military duty, on or after January



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1, 2011, and who otherwise would have been entitled to reemployment rights
under the Uniformed Services Employment and Reemployment Rights Act, 38
U.S.C. § 4301 et seq., as in effect on January 1, 2011, the survivors of that
member are entitled to any additional benefits that would have been provided
under the public employee retirement plan had the member resumed employment
with a covered employer on the day preceding his or her death and then
terminated employment on the actual date of death.

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9 SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 24-2-505(b) and (c), concerning compliance 10 with the Heroes Earnings Assistance and Relief Tax Act of 2008, are amended 11 to read as follows:

12 (b) In the case of a member who becomes disabled while performing 13 qualified military service, including state active military duty, on or after 14 January 1, 2011, and who otherwise would have been entitled to reemployment rights under the federal Uniformed Services Employment and Reemployment 15 Rights Act, 38 U.S.C. § 4301 et seq., as in effect on January 1, 2011, that 16 17 member is considered to have resumed employment with a covered employer on 18 the day preceding the onset of his or her disability and then terminated 19 employment on the actual date he or she became disabled.

(c) A member who dies or becomes disabled while performing qualified military service, including state active military duty, is deemed to have made employee contributions for the purpose of determining benefits other than benefit accruals that are contingent on those contributions for the period of qualified military service.

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26 SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 24-7-602(c)(2), concerning military service 27 credit under the Arkansas Teacher Retirement System, is amended to read as 28 follows:

(2) Under this subsection, uniformed services of the United States is limited to the United States Armed Forces; the Army National Guard and the Air National Guard when engaged in active duty for training, <u>state</u> <u>active duty</u>, inactive duty training, or full-time National Guard duty; the <u>commissioned corps United States Commissioned Corps</u> of the Public Health Service; and any other category of persons designated by the President of the United States in time of war or emergency.

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SECTION 5. Arkansas Code § 24-10-502(d)(2), concerning military
service credit under the Arkansas Local Police and Fire Retirement System, is
amended to read as follows:

4 (2) Under this subsection, the uniformed services of the United 5 States are limited to the United States Armed Forces, the Army National Guard 6 and Air National Guard when engaged in active duty for training, <u>state active</u> 7 <u>duty</u>, inactive duty training, or full-time National Guard duty, the 8 <u>commissioned corps of the United States United States Commissioned Corps of</u> 9 <u>the</u> Public Health Service, and any other category of persons designated by 10 the President of the United States in time of war or national emergency.

SECTION 6. Arkansas Code § 24-11-436(d)(2), concerning military service credit the Police Officers' Pension and Relief Fund for cities of the first class, is amended to read as follows:

15 (2) Under this subsection, the uniformed services of the United 16 States are limited to the United States Armed Forces, the Army National Guard 17 and Air National Guard when engaged in active duty for training, state active 18 duty, inactive duty training, or full-time National Guard duty, the United 19 States Public Health Service Commissioned Corps United States Commissioned 20 Corps of the Public Health Service, and any other category of persons 21 designated by the President of the United States in time of war or national 22 emergency.

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24 SECTION 7. Arkansas Code § 24-11-817(d)(2), concerning military 25 service credit under the firemen's relief and pension funds, is amended to 26 read as follows:

(2) Under this subsection, the uniformed services of the United States are limited to the United States Armed Forces, the Army National Guard and Air National Guard when engaged in active duty for training, <u>state active</u> duty, inactive duty training, or full-time National Guard duty, the United States Public Health Services Commissioned Corps, and any other category of persons designated by the President of the United States in time of war or national emergency.
