32	person elected or appointed to a constitutional office has registered, holds			
33	office on, or acts as the resident agent for more political action committees			
34	than are allowed under this act, the person shall before the end of the			
35	reporting period in which this act becomes effective comply with this act by:			
36	(1) Dissolving the excess political action committees;			

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1	(2) Resigning from his or her office on the excess political	
2	action committees; or	
3	(3) Resigning from his or her position as resident agent for the	
4	excess political action committees.	
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
