25	concentration in biologic or physical science, psychology, and sociology,	and

2	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 17-88-305(c), concerning reciprocity of a
3	license to practice occupational therapy, is amended to read as follows:
4	(c) Any occupational therapist or occupational therapy assistant who
5	has been certified by the American Occupational Therapy Association
6	Accreditation Council of Occupational Therapy and who has been in continuous
7	practice for the past five (5) years and who comes to Arkansas from a state
8	presently not granting reciprocity or from a state not requiring licensing
9	shall be eligible for licensing in Arkansas.
