## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO REAPPROPRIATE THE BALANCES OF CAPITAL  
IMPROVEMENT APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE INSTITUTIONS OF  
HIGHER EDUCATION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

AN ACT FOR THE INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER  
EDUCATION REAPPROPRIATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. REAPPROPRIATION - ARKANSAS STATE UNIVERSITY - JONESBORO -  
DEVELOPMENT AND ENHANCEMENT. There is hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas  
State University, to be payable from the Development and Enhancement Fund,  
for the Arkansas State University the following:

(A) Effective July 1, 2019, the balance of the appropriation provided  
in Item (B) of Section 1 of Act 203 of 2018, for construction, renovation,  
maintenance, equipment, personal services and operating expenses of the  
various institutions and entities of the Arkansas State University System, in  
a sum not to exceed .....\$14,500,000.

(B) Effective July 1, 2019, the balance of the appropriation provided  
in Item (C) of Section 1 of Act 203 of 2018, for construction of a College of  
Engineering building, in a sum not to exceed .....\$4,000,000.

(C) Effective July 1, 2019, the balance of the appropriation provided  
in Item (D) of Section 1 of Act 203 of 2018, for College of Education and  
Communications restrooms renovation, in a sum not to exceed .....\$908,500.

(D) Effective July 1, 2019, the balance of the appropriation provided  
in Item (E) of Section 1 of Act 203 of 2018, for Library HVAC system



renovation and modernization, in a sum not to exceed .....\$2,000,000.

(E) Effective July 1, 2019, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (F) of Section 1 of Act 203 of 2018, for Lab Sciences Lab and HVAC System renovation and modernization, in a sum not to exceed .....\$1,291,500.

(F) Effective July 1, 2019, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (G) of Section 1 of Act 203 of 2018, for critical maintenance, in a sum not to exceed .....\$1,840,000.

(G) Effective July 1, 2019, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (H) of Section 1 of Act 203 of 2018, for deferred maintenance, in a sum not to exceed .....\$4,940,000.

(H) Effective July 1, 2019, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (I) of Section 1 of Act 203 of 2018, for the purchase, replacement, and renewal of equipment and library holdings, in a sum not to exceed .....\$2,342,774.

SECTION 2. REAPPROPRIATION - ARKANSAS STATE UNIVERSITY - JONESBORO - LAKEPORT PLANTATION DAIRY STABILIZATION. There is hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas State University, to be payable from the Arkansas Natural and Cultural Resources Grant and Trust Fund, for the Arkansas State University the following:

(A) Effective July 1, 2019, the balance of the appropriation provided in Section 23 of Act 217 of 2018, for the acquisition, management, stewardship or preservation of state owned lands, historic sites, buildings, structures or objects, in a sum not to exceed .....\$125,376.

SECTION 3. REAPPROPRIATION - ARKANSAS STATE UNIVERSITY - JONESBORO - KAIT - TV NEWS FILM COLLECTION. There is hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas State University, to be payable from the Arkansas Natural and Cultural Resources Grant and Trust Fund, for the Arkansas State University the following:

(A) Effective July 1, 2019, the balance of the appropriation provided in Section 23 of Act 217 of 2018, for the acquisition, management, stewardship or preservation of state owned lands, historic sites, buildings, structures or objects, in a sum not to exceed .....\$40,000.

SECTION 7. REAPPROPRIATION - HENDERSON STATE UNIVERSITY - DEVELOPMENT AND ENHANCEMENT. There is hereby appropriated, to the Henderson State University, to be payable from the Development and Enhancement Fund, for the Henderson State University the following:

(A) Effective July 1, 2019, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (A) of Section 6 of Act 203 of 2018, for construction of a HPER building and renovation of the Wells Building, in a sum not to exceed .....\$3,000,000.

(B) Effective July 1, 2019, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (B) of Section 6 of Act 203 of 2018, for renovation of the Russell Fine Arts Building, in a sum not to exceed .....\$3,000,000.

(A) Effective July 1, 2019, the balance of the appropriation provided in Section 23 of Act 217 of 2018, for the acquisition, management, stewardship or preservation of state owned lands, historic sites, buildings, structures or objects, in a sum not to exceed .....\$24,314.

SECTION 14. REAPPROPRIATION - UNIVERSITY OF ARKANSAS - GARVAN WOODLAND GARDENS WESTERN GARDENS CORRIDOR. There is hereby appropriated, to the University of Arkansas, to be payable from the Arkansas Natural and Cultural

Resources Grant and Trust Fund, for the University of Arkansas the following:

(A) Effective July 1, 2019, the balance of the appropriation provided in Section 23 of Act 217 of 2018, for the acquisition, management, stewardship or preservation of state owned lands, historic sites, buildings, structures or objects, in a sum not to exceed .....\$453,000.

There is hereby appropriated, to the University of Arkansas, to be payable from the Arkansas Natural and Cultural Resources Grant and Trust Fund, for the University of Arkansas the following:

(A) Effective July 1, 2019, the balance of the appropriation provided in Section 23 of Act 217 of 2018, for the acquisition, management, stewardship or preservation of state owned lands, historic sites, buildings, structures or objects, in a sum not to exceed .....\$720,500.

SECTION 16. REAPPROPRIATION - UNIVERSITY OF ARKANSAS - LITTLE ROCK - DEVELOPMENT AND ENHANCEMENT. There is hereby appropriated, to the University of Arkansas at Little Rock, to be payable from the Development and Enhancement Fund, for the University of Arkansas at Little Rock the following:

(A) Effective July 1, 2019, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (A) of Section 15 of Act 203 of 2018, for construction, renovation, maintenance, critical maintenance, equipment, security enhancements, technology upgrades/equipment and library resources, in a sum not to exceed .....\$1,263.

(B) Effective July 1, 2019, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (B) of Section 15 of Act 203 of 2018, for improvements to technology infrastructure, in a sum not to exceed .....\$236,958.

SECTION 23. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor  
obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects  
described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available  
therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and  
agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and  
donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or  
funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State  
Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects  
enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds  
otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General  
Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall  
not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act.

(B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State  
Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the  
Revenue Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of  
this State and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and  
Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in  
disbursement of any funds provided by this act unless specifically provided  
otherwise by law.

SECTION 24. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for  
which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

SECTION 25. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the  
General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits  
the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the

1 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2019 is essential to the operation of  
2 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
3 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the  
4 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2019 could work irreparable harm  
5 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental  
6 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act  
7 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health  
8 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2019.
