2	(4) The Red Tape Reduction Working Group issued a final report
3	to the Governor in the fall of 2018 with five (5) recommendations for
4	substantive legislative reform, which are to:
5	(A) Establish an expedited procedure for occupational
6	licensing entities to collectively submit administrative rules that are
7	responsive to new legislation;
8	(B) Extend Acts 2017, No. 781, to allow repeal of
9	subsections of rules;
10	(C) Establish provisions to allow certain agencies to
11	consider occupational relevance with regard to criminal background issues;
12	(D) Authorize occupational licensing entities to identify
13	types of individuals or entities that may be issued temporary or provisional
14	licenses; and
15	(E) Establish a systematic process for review of:
16	(i) New occupational licensure and occupational
17	licensing entities; and
18	(ii) Existing occupational licensure and
19	occupational licensing entities;
20	(5) Several occupational licenses are needlessly regulated and
21	could be deregulated or de-licensed without causing detrimental harm to the
22	citizens of the State of Arkansas and the economy of the this state;
23	(6) Research has found that occupational licensing reduces
24	access to jobs, inhibits geographic mobility, and raises the costs of
25	services;
26	(b) It is the intent of the General Assembly to amend the laws
27	concerning contractors and to allow registration of subcontractors and
28	eliminate the subcontractor licensing requirement.
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30	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 17-25-101, concerning the definitions under
31	the laws regarding contractors and the licensing of contractors, is amended
32	to add additional subsections to read as follows:
33	(e) "Owner" means a person who owns property or is lessee of property;
34	(f) "Person" means any natural person, limited or general partnership,
35	corporation, association, limited liability company, trust or other legal
36	entity, and any organization capable of conducting business, or any

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1	combination thereof;
2	(g) "Prime contractor" means a contractor who contracts directly with
3	the owner of property; and
4	(h) "Subcontractor" means a person who contracts directly with a prime
5	contractor or another subcontractor.
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7	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 17-25-102, concerning exemptions under the
8	provisions related to the licensing requirements of contractors, is amended
9	to add an additional subdivision to read as follows:
10	(4)(A) Subcontractors of a licensed contractor who are properly
11	registered with the Contractors Licensing Board under this chapter.
12	(B) The Contractors Licensing Board may issue rules
13	necessary for the:
14	(i) Implementation of a registration process;
15	(ii) Determination of application fees for registration;
16	and
17	(iii) Establishment of civil penalties in the same amounts
18	and under the same procedures as for other license holders under this
19	<u>chapter</u> .
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21	SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 17-25-103(a), concerning penalties and
22	enforcement under the laws regarding licensing of contractors, is amended to
23	read as follows:
24	(a) <u>(l)</u> A ny <u>It is a violation of this chapter for any</u> contractor shall
25	be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be liable to a fine of not less
26	than one hundred dollars (\$100) nor more than two hundred dollars (\$200) for
27	each offense, with each day to constitute a separate offense who to knowingly
28	do any of the following:
29	(1)(A)(A)(i) For a fixed price, commission, fee, or wage
30	attempts to or submits a bid or bids to construct or demolish or contracts to
31	construct or demolish, or undertakes to construct or demolish, or assumes
32	charge in a supervisory capacity or otherwise, or manages the construction,
33	erection, alteration, demolition, or repair of, or has constructed, erected,
34	altered, demolished, or repaired, under his or her or its direction, any
35	building, apartment, condominium, highway, sewer, utility, grading, or any
36	other improvement or structure, when the cost of the work to be done, or

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1 done, in the State of Arkansas by the contractor, including, but not limited 2 to, labor and materials, is fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) or more, without 3 first having procured a license or registration with the proper 4 classification to engage in the business of contracting in this state. 5 (B)(ii) Subdivision (a)(1)(a)(1)(A)(i) of this section 6 shall does not apply to any demolition work or other work necessary to clean 7 up a natural disaster within seventy-two (72) hours following the natural 8 disaster; 9 (2)(B) Shall present or file Presents or files the license or 10 registration certificate of another; 11 (3)(C) Shall give <u>Gives</u> false or forged evidence of any kind to 12 the Contractors Licensing Board or any member thereof in obtaining a 13 certificate of license or registration; 14 (4)(D) Shall impersonate Impersonates another; or 15 (5)(E) Shall use Uses an expired or revoked certificate of 16 license or registration; 17 (2) A violation under subsection (a) of this section is a Class 18 A misdemeanor, with each day of activity constituting a separate offense. 19 20 SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 17-25-103(b), concerning penalties and 21 enforcement under the laws regarding licensing of contractors, is amended to 22 read as follows: 23 (b) The doing of any act or thing herein prohibited by any applicant, 24 or licensee, or registrant shall, in the discretion of the board, constitute 25 sufficient grounds to refuse a license or registration to an applicant or to 26 revoke the license of a licensee or the registration of a registrant. 27 28 SECTION 5. Arkansas Code § 17-25-104 is amended to read as follows: 29 17-25-104. Injunction. When any contractor not licensed by the Contractors Licensing Board 30 31 shall engage or attempt engages or attempts to engage in the business of contracting as herein defined, in violation of this chapter, the board 32 Contractors Licensing Board shall have the right to go into the proper court 33 34 in the jurisdiction in which the work is being performed a court where venue 35 is proper and is of competent jurisdiction and, upon affidavit, secure a writ 36 of injunction, without bond, restraining and prohibiting the contractor from

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1 performance of the work then being done or about to commence. 2 3 SECTION 6. Arkansas Code Title 17, Chapter 25, Subchapter 1, is 4 amended to add an additional section to read as follows: 5 17-25-107. Abuse, neglect, or exploitation. 6 (a) The definitions under § 5-28-101 apply to this chapter. 7 (b) Any contractor licensed or registered under this chapter who is suspected by the Contractors Licensing Board or the Residential Contractors 8 9 Committee of the abuse, neglect, or exploitation of an endangered person or 10 an impaired person while engaging in the performing the services of a contractor as defined under § 17-25-101 is subject to emergency license or 11 12 registration suspension under §§ 17-25-309 and 17-25-510. 13 (c) The board may provide evidence, documentation, reports, and 14 information related to the abuse, neglect, or exploitation of an endangered 15 person or an impaired person to any entity with the authority to enforce § 5-16 28-101 et. seq. 17 18 SECTION 7. Arkansas Code § 17-25-301(a), concerning the significance 19 and proof of a certificate of license by the Contractors Licensing Board, is 20 amended to read as follows: 21 (a) The issuance of a certificate of license or registration by the 22 Contractors Licensing Board shall be evidence that the person, firm, or 23 corporation named therein on the certificate of license or registration is 24 entitled to all of the rights and privileges of a licensed or registered 25 contractor while the license or registration remains unrevoked or unexpired. 26 27 SECTION 8. Arkansas Code § 17-25-302 is amended to read as follows: 28 17-25-302. Limitations. The Contractors Licensing Board shall have power to limit by proper 29 30 classification the license or registration to the character of work for which 31 the applicant is qualified. 32 33 SECTION 9. Arkansas Code § 17-25-303(a)(1)(A), concerning the 34 application, renewal, and fees required for licensure as a contractor, is 35 amended to read as follows: 36 (a)(1)(A) Any A person desiring to be licensed or registered as a

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1 contractor in this state shall make and file with the Contractors Licensing 2 Board thirty (30) days before any regular or special meeting thereof of the 3 board, a written application on a form as may then be prescribed by the board, for examination by the board. 4 5 6 SECTION 10. Arkansas Code § 17-25-303(b), concerning the application, 7 renewal, and fees required for licensure as a contractor, is amended to read 8 as follows: 9 (b) Thereafter, an annual renewal license or registration fee to be 10 determined by the board but not to exceed one hundred dollars (\$100) shall be paid by each licensee or registrant to defray the costs and expenses of the 11 12 administration of this chapter. 13 14 SECTION 11. Arkansas Code § 17-25-304, concerning financial statements 15 filed with the Contractors Licensing Board, is amended to add an additional 16 subsection to read as follows: 17 (c)(1) In lieu of providing a financial statement showing a minimum 18 net worth for a person or entity required to be licensed or registered by the 19 Contractors Licensing Board as required by subsections (a) and (b) of this 20 section, an applicant may provide a surety bond from: (A) A surety authorized to transact surety business in the 21 22 State of Arkansas; and 23 (B) A surety listed on the current United States Department of the Treasury's List of Approved Sureties; 24 25 (2) The surety bond shall be in an amount ten (10) times the required net worth for the applicant's license or registration classification 26 27 with his or her initial or renewal application. 28 (3) The surety shall maintain a rating of performance from A. M. 29 Best Company, Inc., or its successor rating organization, of "A" as stated in the most current publication of Best's Key Rating Guide, Property/Casualty-30 31 United States and Canada. 32 (4) The surety bond provided under this subsection shall: (A) Be continuous in form; 33 34 (B)(i) Be maintained in effect for as long as the 35 applicant maintains the license or registration issued by the board; 36 (ii) If an applicant submits a financial statement

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1	showing that the applicant meets the net worth requirements for the license
2	or registration, the surety bond may be cancelled;
3	(C)(i) List the State of Arkansas as obligee for the bond.
4	(ii) The State shall have priority over all other
5	claims to recover against the bond;
6	(D) Be for the benefit of any person who is damaged by:
7	(i) An act or omission of the applicant constituting
8	a breach of construction contract or a contract for the furnishing of labor,
9	materials, or professional services for construction undertaken by the
10	applicant; or
11	(ii) An unlawful act or omission of the applicant in
12	performing the services of a contractor as defined under § 17-25-101; and
13	(E) Be in addition to, and not in lieu of, any other
14	surety bond required of the applicant by law or rule, or by any party to a
15	contract with the applicant.
16	(5)(A) The surety bond provided in subsection (c) of this
17	section may only be canceled by notification to the board by the surety and
18	the applicant sixty days before cancellation.
19	(B) When the surety bond is canceled, the licensee or
20	registrant shall provide a replacement bond or submit a financial statement
21	as required by § 17-25-304 before the effective date of the cancellation or
22	the license or registration of the licensee or registrant shall be suspended.
23	(6) The board may adopt rules necessary to enforce this
24	subsection.
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26	SECTION 12. Arkansas Code § 17-25-307 is amended to read as follows:
27	17-25-307. Expiration.
28	All certificates of license <u>or registration</u> to engage in the business
29	of contracting in performing the services of a contractor as defined under §
30	<u>17-25-101</u> in the State of Arkansas shall expire at 12:00 midnight on the day
31	before the anniversary date of their issuance unless otherwise designated by
32	the Contractors Licensing Board, and they <u>all certificates of license or</u>
33	registration shall become invalid on that day unless renewed.
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35	SECTION 13. Arkansas Code § 17-25-308(a), concerning the grounds for
36	revocation of a contractor's license, is amended to read as follows:

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1 (a) The Contractors Licensing Board may revoke the certificate of 2 license <u>or registration</u> of any contractor licensed <u>or registered</u> under this 3 chapter who is found guilty of any fraud or deceit in obtaining a license <u>or</u> 4 <u>registration</u> or for aiding or abetting any contractor or person to violate 5 the provisions of this chapter or for gross negligence, incompetence, or 6 misconduct in the conduct of the contractor's business.

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8 SECTION 14. Arkansas Code § 17-25-309(a), concerning the procedure for 9 revocation and reissuance of a contractor's license, is amended to read as 10 follows:

11 (a) Any person may prefer charges in connection with the foregoing 12 against any contractor licensed <u>or registered</u> under this chapter. 13

14 SECTION 15. Arkansas Code § 17-25-309(f) and (g), concerning the 15 procedure for revocation and reissuance of a contractor's license, are 16 amended to read as follows:

17 (f) If after the hearing the board finds the facts as alleged and of 18 such character as to disqualify the contractor, then the board shall revoke 19 the license <u>or registration</u> of the contractor, but in that event no refund 20 shall be made of the license <u>or registration</u> fee.

(g) Within its discretion and upon proper application or hearing, the board may reissue a license <u>or registration</u> to any contractor whose license <u>or registration</u> has been revoked.

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25 SECTION 16. Arkansas Code § 17-25-309, concerning the procedure for 26 revocation and reissuance of a contractor's license, is amended to add an 27 additional subsection to read as follows:

(h)(1) When suspected abuse, neglect, or exploitation of an endangered
 person or an impaired person is suspected, the Contractors Licensing Board
 may:

31 <u>(A) State in writing that due to imminent physical or</u>
32 <u>other harm to the endangered person or impaired person, the situation merits</u>
33 <u>the emergency suspension of a license or registration; and</u>

34 (B) Proceed with the suspension of a license or

35 registration without a hearing or upon any abbreviated hearing that the board

36 <u>finds practicable to suspend the license or registration;</u>

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1 (2) The emergency suspension shall become effective immediately, 2 unless otherwise stated in the written determination by the board. 3 (3) The emergency suspension may be effective for a period of 4 thirty (30) days or less and the emergency suspension shall not be renewable. 5 (4) When an emergency suspension is ordered, a formal suspension 6 or revocation proceeding shall be promptly instituted and acted upon in 7 accordance with the Arkansas Administrative Procedure Act, § 25-15-201 et 8 seq. 9 10 SECTION 17. Arkansas Code § 17-25-310 is amended to read as follows: 11 17-25-310. Replacement. 12 A certificate of license or registration to replace any lost, 13 destroyed, or mutilated certificate may be issued subject to the rules and regulations of the Contractors Licensing Board. 14 15 16 SECTION 18. Arkansas Code § 17-25-316 is amended to read as follows: 17 17-25-316. Workers' compensation coverage required. (a) A contractor required to be licensed or registered by the 18 19 Contractors Licensing Board shall obtain and maintain workers' compensation 20 coverage as required under the Workers' Compensation Law, § 11-9-101 et seq. 21 (b) The board shall require proof of current workers' compensation 22 coverage before issuing or renewing a license or registration to a contractor 23 required to have workers' compensation coverage under the Workers' 24 Compensation Law § 11-9-101 et seq. 25 (c)(1) If a contractor fails to maintain workers' compensation 26 coverage or fails to maintain proof of current workers' compensation coverage 27 on file with the board, the board may revoke or suspend the contractor's 28 license or registration. (2) A contractor's license or registration that has been revoked 29 30 or suspended due to failure to maintain workers' compensation coverage may be 31 reinstated upon receipt by the board of proof that the contractor has secured workers' compensation coverage. 32 33 (d) The board shall promulgate rules necessary to enforce this 34 section. 35 36 SECTION 19. Arkansas Code § 17-25-401(a)(2), concerning the definition

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1 of "contractor" under the laws regarding contractors licensing, is amended to 2 read as follows: 3 (2) The term As used in this subchapter "contractor" includes: (A) All original, prime, and general contractors; and 4 5 (B) A contractor who is required to obtain a contractor's 6 license or registration under the state licensing law of this state, § 17-25-7 101 et seq. 8 9 SECTION 20. Arkansas Code § 17-25-504, concerning the authority of the 10 Residential Contractors Committee, is amended to add an additional 11 subdivision to read as follows: 12 (8) Award restitution to a property owner. 13 14 SECTION 21. Arkansas Code § 17-25-505, concerning the requirement of a 15 license from the Residential Contractors Committee, is amended to add a new 16 subsection to read as follows: 17 (c) Any person, firm, partnership, copartnership, association, 18 corporation, limited liability company, or other organization that fails to 19 procure a license as required under this subchapter shall be deemed guilty of 20 a Class A misdemeanor with each day in violation of the requirement to 21 constitute a separate offense. 22 23 SECTION 22. Arkansas Code § 17-25-510, concerning hearings by the 24 Residential Contractors Committee regarding violations, is amended to add an 25 additional subsection to read as follows: 26 (d)(1) When suspected abuse, neglect, or exploitation of an endangered 27 person or an impaired person is suspected, the Residential Contractors 28 Committee may: 29 (A) State in writing that due to imminent physical or 30 other harm to the endangered person or impaired person, the situation merits the emergency suspension of a license or registration; and 31 32 (B) Proceed with the suspension of a license or 33 registration without a hearing or upon any abbreviated hearing that the 34 committee finds practicable to suspend the license or registration; 35 (2) The emergency suspension shall become effective immediately, 36 unless otherwise stated in the written documentation by the board.

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1	(3) The emergency suspension may be effective for a period of
2	longer than thirty (30) days and the emergency suspension shall not be
3	renewable.
4	(4) When an emergency suspension is ordered, a formal suspension
5	or revocation proceeding shall be promptly instituted and acted upon in
6	accordance with the Arkansas Administrative Procedure Act, § 25-15-201 et
7	seq.
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9	SECTION 23. EFFECTIVE DATE. This act is effective on and after July
10	<u>1, 2020.</u>
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
