25	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 8-6-607 is	amended to read as follows:
26	8-6-607. Collection of fees.	
27	27 Fees imposed under the separate provisi	ons of this subchapter shall be
28	28 <del>collected as follows</del> <u>(a) On or before Januar</u>	y 15, April 15, July 15, and
29	29 October 15 of each year, each landfill permit	tee and each solid waste
30	30 <u>transporter shall</u> :	
31	31 (1) Each landfill permittee and	each solid waste transporter
32	32 shall submit <u>Submit</u> to the Arkansas Departmen	t of Environmental Quality <del>on or</del>
33	33 before January 15, April 15, July 15, and Oct	<del>ober 15 of each year</del> a quarterly
34	report that accurately states the total weigh	t or volume of solid waste

5	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code Title 8, Chapter 7, Subchapter 1, is amended	
6	to add an additional section to read as follows:	
7	8-7-102. Public school assistance.	
8	Subject to the availability and appropriation of funding, the Director	
9	of the Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality may implement and	
10	administer a grant program to assist public schools as defined in § 6-15-2903	
11	with the disposal or recycling of hazardous waste as defined in the Arkansas	
12	Hazardous Waste Management Act of 1979, § 8-7-201 et seq., and applicable	
13	rules of the Arkansas Pollution Control and Ecology Commission.	
14		
15	SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 8-9-104, concerning the definitions related	
16	to recycling, is amended to add an additional subdivision to read as follows:	
17	(13) "Person" means an individual, municipality, other	
18	governmental entity, or another entity recognized by law with rights and	
19	duties.	
20		
21	SECTION 4. Arkansas Code Title 8, Chapter 9, Subchapter 2, is amended	
22	to add an additional section to read as follows:	
23	8-9-205. Statewide recycling program.	
24	(a) Subject to the availability and appropriation of funding, the	
25	Director of the Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality may implement	
26	and administer a grant program for recycling assistance under this chapter	
27	for the administration of one (1) statewide recycling program for one (1) or	
28	more of the following:	
29	(1) Management of recycling programs under the direction of the	
30	Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality;	
31	(2) Administration of recycling programs for business and	
32	industry;	
33	(3) Performance of public outreach services, including without	
34	limitation surveys and public service announcements; and	
35	(4) Other components of the statewide recycling program that the	
36	director determines necessary for program effectiveness.	

1	(b) A person is erigible to apply for a grant under this section if	
2	the person demonstrates:	
3	(1) At least twenty-five (25) years of experience in the	
4	recycling industry; and	
5	(2) The current capacity to fulfill all of the duties under	
6	subsection (a) of this section determined necessary for the statewide	
7	recycling program as determined by the director.	
8	(c) The director shall determine whether a person eligible under	
9	subsection (b) of this section is qualified to administer the statewide	
10	recycling program and shall select a person eligible under subsection (b) of	
11	this section to administer the statewide recycling program.

13	SECTION 5. Arkansas Code Title 19, Chapter 5, Subchapter 12, is	
14	amended to add additional sections to read as follows:	
15	19-5-1264. Environmental Assistance to Public Schools Fund.	
16	(a) There is created on the books of the Treasurer of State, the	
17	Auditor of State, and the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State a miscellaneous	
18	fund to be known as the "Environmental Assistance to Public Schools Fund".	
19	(b) The fund shall consist of:	
20	(1) That portion of moneys under § 8-6-607(b)(3)(C); and	
21	(2) Any other revenues authorized by law.	
22	(c) The fund shall be used by the Arkansas Department of Environmental	
23	Quality to provide assistance under § 8-7-102.

26	(a) There is created on the books of the Treasurer of State, the	
27	Auditor of State, and the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State a miscellaneous

31	(2) Any other revenues authorized by law.	
32	(c) The fund shall be used by the Arkansas Department of Environmenta

35	SECTION 6. TEMPORARY LANGUAGE. DO NOT CODIFY. This act applies to	
36	annual disbursements under § 8-6-607 beginning in fiscal year 2020.
