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33 SECTION 14. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 34 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER
 35 OF FUNDS - JUSTICE BUILDING OPERATIONS ACTUAL EXPENDITURES. Department of
 36 Finance and Administration - Building Authority Division may from time to

1 time as may be necessary and in such amounts as may be necessary and with the
2 approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, request a transfer of
3 funds from the State Central Services Fund to the Arkansas Building Authority
4 Maintenance Fund for operation of the Justice Building for actual
5 expenditures, in an amount not to exceed the dollar amount appropriated in
6 the Justice Building Operation Section. Upon his approval, the Chief Fiscal
7 Officer of the State shall then initiate the necessary transfer documents to
8 reflect the transfer upon the fiscal records of the State Auditor, the State
9 Treasurer, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and Department of Finance
10 and Administration - Building Authority Division.

11 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2018~~
12 2019 through June 30, ~~2019~~ 2020.

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14 SECTION 15. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
15 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER
16 OF FUNDS. The Department of Finance and Administration - Building Authority
17 Division is hereby authorized, after seeking the approval of the Chief Fiscal
18 Officer of the State and the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget
19 Committee to request transfer from the appropriation made in the Building
20 Maintenance Section for Building Maintenance to the Acquisition and
21 Maintenance appropriation in the Acquisition and Maintenance Section and to
22 receive from another state agency that seeks like approvals its authority,
23 appropriation and the transfer of funds to be deposited into the Building
24 Authority Division Real Estate Fund to become part of the Acquisition and
25 Maintenance appropriation, and to be used for any purposes as set forth by
26 law for said Real Estate Fund.

27 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of
28 appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year
29 is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by
30 delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and
31 the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by
32 amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly
33 has determined that the Department of Finance and Administration - Building
34 Authority Division may operate more efficiently if some flexibility is
35 provided to the Department of Finance and Administration - Building Authority
36 Division authorizing broad powers under this section. Therefore, it is both

1 necessary and appropriate that the General Assembly maintain oversight by
2 requiring prior approval of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee
3 as provided by this section. The requirement of approval by the Legislative
4 Council or Joint Budget Committee is not a severable part of this section.
5 If the requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget
6 Committee is ruled unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction,
7 this entire section is void.

8 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2018~~
9 2019 through June 30, ~~2019~~ 2020.

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11 SECTION 16. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
12 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.

13 DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION - BUILDING AUTHORITY DIVISION
14 CONTINGENCY APPROPRIATION TRANSFER AUTHORITY. The Department of Finance and
15 Administration - Building Authority Division may transfer appropriation and
16 funds as needed from the Facilities Management Contingency Appropriation in
17 the Building Maintenance Section of this Act to any appropriation authorized
18 for the Department of Finance and Administration - Building Authority
19 Division.

20 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2018~~
21 2019 through June 30, ~~2019~~ 2020.

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23 SECTION 17. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
24 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER
25 TO FACILITIES MANAGEMENT CONTINGENCY APPROPRIATION AUTHORITY. (a) In order to
26 provide a more cost effective method to address the emerging infrastructure
27 needs of Arkansas State Government, appropriations and funds transferred to
28 the Facilities Management Contingency Appropriation are to be used in the
29 event that the Department of Finance and Administration - Building Authority
30 Division executes one or more building contracts or maintenance agreements
31 with State Agencies, and the appropriations or funds otherwise provided for
32 the Department of Finance and Administration - Building Authority Division
33 are not sufficient to address those needs, and it is more cost effective for
34 the Department of Finance and Administration - Building Authority Division to
35 execute these services. Any State Agency may transfer or deposit funds and
36 appropriations to the Department of Finance and Administration - Building

1 Authority Division - Facilities Management Contingency Appropriation
2 authorized in the Building Maintenance Section of this Act to execute one or
3 more building contracts or maintenance agreements with said State Agencies.
4 The Department of Finance and Administration - Building Authority Division
5 shall provide justification to the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State for the
6 need of such appropriations and funds transfers and seek and receive approval
7 of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State. Department of Finance and
8 Administration - Building Authority Division shall then seek and receive the
9 approval of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee. The
10 requirement of approval by the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget
11 Committee is not a severable part of the section. If the requirement of
12 approval by the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is
13 ruled unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, this entire
14 section is void.

15 (b) The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall make the necessary
16 adjustments on his or her books and the books of the Auditor of the State for
17 the transfer or deposit of the funds and appropriations from each State
18 Agency to the appropriation authorized in the Building Maintenance Section of
19 this Act and to the various Department of Finance and Administration -
20 Building Authority Division accounts to be used exclusively by the Department
21 of Finance and Administration - Building Authority Division for the fiscal
22 year.

23 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2018~~
24 2019 through June 30, ~~2019~~ 2020.

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26 SECTION 18. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
27 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.

28 SUSTAINABLE BUILDING DESIGN PROGRAM - TRANSFER. In the event there is not
29 sufficient appropriation and/or funding provided for by the General Assembly
30 for any state agency, board or commission to participate in the Sustainable
31 Building Design Program for renovations of state owned property which exceeds
32 two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000), the agency may request a
33 transfer from the Sustainable Building Design Program appropriation
34 authorized in the Sustainable Building Design Program Section of this Act
35 from the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State. The request shall clearly state
36 the amount required and such other information as may be required by the

1 Chief Fiscal Officer of the State necessary to make a decision regarding the
2 request. Upon approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and prior
3 review by the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee, the
4 State Auditor shall be notified as of the amount and the purposes for which
5 the appropriation and/or funding is to be transferred and shall be
6 established upon the books of the Department of Finance and Administration
7 and the State Auditor. If desired, the appropriation may be supplemental to
8 those regularly appropriated for like purposes by the General Assembly for
9 that agency.

10 Provided further, that all state agencies, boards or commissions shall
11 have prior approval by the Department of Finance and Administration -
12 Building Authority Division as authorized for the Sustainable Building Design
13 Program in accordance with established Rules and Regulations.

14 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2018~~
15 2019 through June 30, ~~2019~~ 2020.

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17 SECTION 19. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
18 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.
19 SUSTAINABLE BUILDING DESIGN PROGRAM - REVOLVING LOAN FUND. The Sustainable
20 Building Design Program Appropriation is intended to provide additional
21 appropriation authority for the Sustainable Building Design Program. Funding
22 for the program may be made available by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the
23 State, in the form of a loan, from a transfer from the Sustainable Building
24 Design Revolving Loan Fund after the required review by the Arkansas
25 Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee, approval by the Chief Fiscal
26 Officer of the State and approval through rules and regulations established
27 and administered by the Department of Finance and Administration - Building
28 Authority Division. Moneys made available for the repayment of a loan shall
29 be deposited to the credit of the Sustainable Building Design Revolving Loan
30 Fund as a "Refund to Expenditure" for the year in which the deposit is made.
31 In the event that the funds for the repayment of a loan are held in
32 depositories other than the State Treasury, the administrative head of the
33 affected state agency shall issue a check drawn against the funds, which
34 shall be deposited in the Sustainable Building Design Revolving Loan Fund.

35 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2018~~
36 2019 through June 30, ~~2019~~ 2020.

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2 SECTION 20. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
3 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUNDING
4 TRANSFER - GENERAL IMPROVEMENT FUNDS. The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State
5 may transfer from time to time on his or her books and those of the State
6 Treasurer and the Auditor of the State funding which is made available from
7 General Improvement Funds allocated and distributed to the Department of
8 Finance and Administration - Building Authority Division in an amount not to
9 exceed three million dollars (\$3,000,000) from the General Improvement Fund
10 or its successor fund or fund accounts to the Sustainable Building Design
11 Revolving Loan Fund to provide funds for the appropriation provided herein or
12 for appropriation authority as may be provided by law to provide loans to
13 agencies for the Sustainable Building Design Program.

14 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2018~~
15 2019 through June 30, ~~2019~~ 2020.

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17 SECTION 21. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
18 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUNDING
19 TRANSFER - FEDERAL FUNDS. From time to time, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the
20 State may transfer on his or her books and those of the State Treasurer and
21 the Auditor of the State the sum not to exceed twelve million dollars
22 (\$12,000,000) from Federal Funds as determined by the Chief Fiscal Officer of
23 the State to the Sustainable Building Design Revolving Loan Fund to provide
24 funds for the appropriations herein.

25 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2018~~
26 2019 through June 30, ~~2019~~ 2020.

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28 SECTION 22. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
29 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUNDING
30 TRANSFER - CASH FUND ACCOUNT. The Department of Finance and Administration -
31 Building Authority Division is authorized to transfer any unspent funds
32 remaining in any cash fund account established for the management of a state
33 owned facility managed by, but not owned by, the Department of Finance and
34 Administration - Building Authority Division to the Department of Finance and
35 Administration - Building Authority Maintenance Fund to support the
36 facility's Maintenance and Operations appropriations.

1 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2018~~
2 2019 through June 30, ~~2019~~ 2020.

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4 SECTION 23. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
5 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUNDING
6 TRANSFER - INSURANCE DEPARTMENT TRUST FUND. Department of Finance and
7 Administration - Building Authority Division may from time to time as may be
8 necessary and in such amounts as may be necessary and with the approval of
9 the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, request a transfer of funds from the
10 Insurance Department Trust Fund to the Building Authority Division Real
11 Estate Fund to provide funds for land acquisition and building construction
12 in an amount not to exceed the dollar amount appropriated in the Acquisition
13 and Maintenance Section. Upon his approval, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the
14 State shall then initiate the necessary transfer documents to reflect the
15 transfer upon the fiscal records of the State Auditor, the State Treasurer,
16 the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and Department of Finance and
17 Administration - Building Authority Division.

18 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2018~~
19 2019 through June 30, ~~2019~~ 2020.

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21 SECTION 24. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
22 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
23 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
24 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
25 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
26 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
27 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
28 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
29 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

30
31 SECTION 25. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
32 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
33 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
34 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
35 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
36 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or

1 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
2 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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4 SECTION 26. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
5 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits
6 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
7 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2019 is essential to the operation of
8 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
9 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
10 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2019 could work irreparable harm
11 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
12 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
13 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
14 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2019.
