SECTION 22. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 28 29 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUNDING 30 TRANSFER - CASH FUND ACCOUNT. The Department of Finance and Administration -31 Building Authority Division is authorized to transfer any unspent funds 32 remaining in any cash fund account established for the management of a state 33 owned facility managed by, but not owned by, the Department of Finance and 34 Administration - Building Authority Division to the Department of Finance and 35 Administration - Building Authority Maintenance Fund to support the 36 facility's Maintenance and Operations appropriations.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2018
 2019 through June 30, 2019 2020.

SECTION 23. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 4 5 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUNDING 6 TRANSFER - INSURANCE DEPARTMENT TRUST FUND. Department of Finance and Administration - Building Authority Division may from time to time as may be 7 8 necessary and in such amounts as may be necessary and with the approval of 9 the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, request a transfer of funds from the 10 Insurance Department Trust Fund to the Building Authority Division Real 11 Estate Fund to provide funds for land acquisition and building construction 12 in an amount not to exceed the dollar amount appropriated in the Acquisition 13 and Maintenance Section. Upon his approval, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the 14 State shall then initiate the necessary transfer documents to reflect the 15 transfer upon the fiscal records of the State Auditor, the State Treasurer, 16 the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and Department of Finance and 17 Administration - Building Authority Division.

21 SECTION 24. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds 22 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency 23 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and 24 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 25 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 26 27 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 28 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 29 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

31 SECTION 25. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General 32 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 33 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for 34 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 35 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 36 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or

summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. SECTION 26. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2019 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2019 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2019. /s/Joint Budget Committee
