12 PROCEEDS USED FOR SCHOLARSHIPS INCREASE YEAR BY YEAR;

17 TO REQUIRE THAT A CERTAIN PERCENTAGE OF
18 LOTTERY PROCEEDS BE NET PROCEEDS THAT ARE
19 USED FOR SCHOLARSHIPS; AND TO REQUIRE
20 THAT THE PERCENTAGE OF NET PROCEEDS USED
21 FOR SCHOLARSHIPS INCREASE YEAR BY YEAR.

24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
25

26 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 23-115-801(a)(3), concerning the percentage
27 of net proceeds from a lottery under the Arkansas Scholarship Lottery Act, is
28 amended to read as follows:

29 (3) The percentage of lottery proceeds determined by the office
30 to be net proceeds shall equal an amount ~~determined by the office to maximize~~
31 ~~net proceeds for scholarships~~ that is not less than the following:

32 (A) For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2020, twenty
33 percent (20%) of lottery proceeds;

34 (B) For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2021, twenty-one
35 percent (21%) of lottery proceeds;

36 (C) For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2022, twenty-two



1 percent (22%) of lottery proceeds;

2 (D) For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2023, twenty-three
3 percent (23%) of lottery proceeds;

4 (E) For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2024, twenty-four
5 percent (24%) of lottery proceeds; and

6 (F) For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2025, and each
7 fiscal year thereafter, twenty-five percent (25%) of lottery proceeds.
