## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO REQUIRE THAT A CERTAIN PERCENTAGE OF LOTTERY PROCEEDS BE NET PROCEEDS THAT ARE USED FOR SCHOLARSHIPS; TO REQUIRE THAT THE PERCENTAGE OF NET PROCEEDS USED FOR SCHOLARSHIPS INCREASE YEAR BY YEAR; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

> TO REQUIRE THAT A CERTAIN PERCENTAGE OF LOTTERY PROCEEDS BE NET PROCEEDS THAT ARE USED FOR SCHOLARSHIPS; AND TO REQUIRE THAT THE PERCENTAGE OF NET PROCEEDS USED FOR SCHOLARSHIPS INCREASE YEAR BY YEAR.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 23-115-801(a)(3), concerning the percentage of net proceeds from a lottery under the Arkansas Scholarship Lottery Act, is amended to read as follows:
(3) The percentage of lottery proceeds determined by the office to be net proceeds shall equal an amount determined by the office to maximize net proceeds for scholarships that is not less than the following:
(A) For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2020, twenty
percent (20\%) of lottery proceeds;
(B) For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2021, twenty-one percent ( $21 \%$ ) of lottery proceeds;
(C) For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2022, twenty-two
percent (22\%) of lottery proceeds;
(D) For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2023, twenty-three
percent (23\%) of lottery proceeds;
(E) For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2024, twenty-four percent (24\%) of lottery proceeds; and
(F) For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2025, and each fiscal year thereafter, twenty-five percent (25\%) of lottery proceeds. fiscal year
