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1 (2) A health insurer or a related entity shall maintain the 2 health insurer's or the related entity's books, records, and documents in a 3 manner that allows the commissioner to readily ascertain during a market 4 conduct examination the health insurer's or the related entity's practices 5 regarding network adequacy, utilization review, quality assessment and 6 improvement, and provider credentialing. 7 (3) The records described under subdivisions (f)(1) and (2) of 8 this section shall be retained for the current year and the five (5) previous 9 calendar years. 10 SECTION 2.
