2	(2) If a vacancy occurs on the task force, the vacancy shall be		
3	filled by the same process as the original appointment.		
4	(3) The members of the task force shall be paid per diem and		
5	$\underline{\text{mileage}}$ as authorized by law for attendance at meetings of interim committees		
6	of the General Assembly.		
7	(c)(1) The cochairs shall call the first meeting of the task force		
8	within sixty (60) days of the effective date of this act.		
9	(2) In order to interact directly with veterans throughout the		
10	State of Arkansas, the task force may hold meetings at various sites		
11	throughout the state.		
12	(3) Meetings of the task force shall be held at least one (1)		
13	time every three (3) months but may occur more often at the call of the		
14	cochairs.		
15	(4) The task force shall establish rules and procedures for		
16	conducting its business.		
17	(5)(A) A majority of the members of the task force shall		
18	constitute a quorum for transacting business of the task force.		
19	(B) An affirmative vote of a majority of a quorum present		
20	is required for the passage of a motion or other task force action.		
21	(6) The Bureau of Legislative Research shall provide staff for		
22	the task force.		
23	(d)(1) The purpose of the task force is to conduct a study of		
24	veterans' issues within the State of Arkansas, including without limitation a		
25	study regarding the occurrence of suicide among the veteran population in		
26	this state.		
27	(2) In carrying out its purpose, the task force shall:		
28	(A) Study risk factors for suicide in veterans;		
29	(B) Review and research options for preventing or reducing		
30	the occurrence of suicide among the veteran population in the state;		
31	(C) Examine mental health care available to veterans		
32	within the state;		
33	(D) Conduct at least one (1) town-hall-style meeting to		
34	hear from veterans in the state and their concerns regarding mental health		
35	care and other issues affecting veterans in the state;		
36	(E) Engage the following:		

1	(i) The Department of Veterans Affairs;		
2	(ii) The Department of Health; and		
3	(iii) Mental health professionals licensed to		
4	practice in this state;		
5	(F) Review best practices among other states;		
6	(G) Review methods to create a statewide program targeting		
7	suicide prevention and preventative mental health care for veterans; and		
8	(H) Study and review other issues that the task force		
9	deems relevant to improving the productivity and wellness of veterans		
10	residing in this state.		
11	(e) The task force may establish an advisory board to assist the task		
12	force in accomplishing its purposes as stated in this act. If the task force		
13	determines that creation of an advisory board would be beneficial, it shall		
14	adopt rules regarding the membership and duties of the advisory board.		
15	(f) The task force shall file with the Governor, the Speaker of the		
16	House of Representatives, and the President Pro Tempore of the Senate a final		
17	written report on or before December 1, 2020.		
18	(g) The task force shall expire on December 31, 2020.		
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
