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SECTION 4. APPROPRIATION - GOVERNOR'S EMERGENCY PROCLAMATION. There is hereby appropriated, to the Office of the Governor, to be payable from the Miscellaneous Revolving Fund, for the purpose provided by Arkansas Code 19-2-

1 404 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2020, the following: 2 ITEM 3 FISCAL YEAR 4 NO. 2019-2020 5 (01) GOVERNOR'S EMERGENCY PROCLAMATION \$500,000 6 7 SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 8 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER 9 PROVISION. After receiving approval from the Chief Fiscal Officer of the 10 State, and prior review by the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget 11 Committee, the Agency is authorized to transfer appropriation from any line 12 item authorized in Operations Appropriation of the Governor's Office in this 13 Act to any other line item authorized in Operations Appropriation. 14 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2018 15 2019 through June 30, 2019 2020. 16 17 SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 18 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. SALARIES. 19 In order that exceptionally well-qualified personnel may be recruited and 20 retained, the Office of the Governor may exceed the maximum salary levels by 21 no more than twenty percent (20%) for no more than one-third (1/3) of the 22 positions authorized in the operation appropriation act after receiving 23 approval from the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee. 24 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2018 25 2019 through June 30, 2019 2020. 26 27 SECTION 7. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds 28 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency 29 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 30 31 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 32 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 33 34 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 35 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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1	SECTION 8. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General			
2	Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations			
3	contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for			
4	which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive			
5	Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget			
6	manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or			
7	summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative			
8	Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.			
9				
10	SECTION 9. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General			
11	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the			
12	appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the			
13	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2019 is essential to the operation of			
14	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in			
15	the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the			
16	effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2019 could work irreparable harm			
17	upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental			
18	programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act			
19	being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health			
20	and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2019.			
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
