22	(k) Upon filing the petition, the prosecuting attorney for the	
23	judicial district may also seek such protective orders as are necessary <u>a</u>	
24	protective order to prevent the transfer, encumbrance, or other disposal of	
25	any property named in the petition.	
26	(1) The law enforcement agency to which the property <u>a motor vehicle</u>	
27	is forfeited shall <u>either</u> :	
28	(1) Destroy any forfeited firearm; and

2	follows:
3	(p)(1) The law enforcement agency to which a firearm is forfeited may
4	trade the firearm to a federally licensed firearms dealer for credit toward
5	future purchases by the law enforcement agency.
6	(2) If the firearm is unable to be traded to a federally
7	licensed firearms dealer, the law enforcement agency may dispose of the
8	firearm as the law enforcement agency deems appropriate.
