14	the state, agency of the state, county, municipality, school district, or		
15	other local taxing unit through a secure, interactive electronic system from		
16	which prospective bidders may download the plans and specifications;		
17	(D) The date, time, and place at which sealed bids will be		
18	received, including notice of the option to submit bids through a secure,		
19	interactive electronic system selected to receive bids for the state, agency		
20	of the state, county, municipality, school district, or other local taxing		
21	unit;		
22	(E) The amount, which may be stated in a percentage, of		
23	the bid bond required;		
24	(F) A statement of the taxing unit's reservation of the		
25	right to reject any or all bids and to waive any formalities; and		
26	(G) Such other pertinent facts or information which to it		
27	may appear necessary or desirable.		
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
