33	SECTION 2. COMPL	JANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disburse	ement of funds	
34	authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency			
35	and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and			
36	the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and			

1 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 2 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 3 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 4 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 5 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds. 6 7 SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General 8 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 9 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for 10 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 11 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 12 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 13 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative 14 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 15 16 SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General 17 Assembly, that funds provided by the General Assembly for the operations of 18 the Department of Parks and Tourism are, due to unforeseen circumstances, 19 insufficient for the Department of Parks and Tourism to continue to provide 20 essential governmental services; that the provisions of this act will provide the necessary monies for the Department of Parks and Tourism to continue such 21 22 services; and that a delay in the effective date of this Act could work 23 irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist 24 25 and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 26 peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after the 27 date of its passage and approval. If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall 28 29 become effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the 30 Governor may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house 31 32 overrides the veto. 33 34 35

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
