- 22 physician who is trained in the United States and has similar qualifications
- 23 and training for the designated position over the previous twelve (12)

- (c)(1) The Arkansas State Medical Board shall issue each educational
- 26 <u>academic</u> license for a period of one (1) year.
- 27 (2) At the end of the one (1) year, the academic license shall
- 28 lapse, and the physician shall make an additional application to the Arkansas
- 29 State Medical Board if the physician desires to continue the practice of
- 30 medicine under the academic license.
- 31 (3) At the end of the second year of practice with an academic
- 32 <u>license</u>, the physician is eligible for an active, unrestricted license to
- 33 practice medicine in the state and shall be granted an active, unrestricted
- 34 license to practice medicine in the state upon application.
- 35 (d) A physician who obtains an educational academic license to
- 36 practice medicine in the State of Arkansas shall comply with the Arkansas
