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- 6 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 22-5-209 is amended to read as follows:
- 7 22-5-209. Deeds, abstracts, and contracts affecting state lands filed
- 8 in office of Commissioner of State Lands Additional information Failure
- 9 to comply.
- 10 (a) All deeds, abstracts, contracts, and other evidences of title to
- 11 realty belonging to the State of Arkansas shall be filed in the office of the
- 12 Commissioner of State Lands to be preserved by the Commissioner of State
- 13 Lands as the other public records and files of his or her office.
- 14 (b) In the event any state office, department, agency, or institution
- 15 fails or refuses to Separately for each item of real property in the
- 16 possession of a state agency, the state agency shall maintain and furnish to
- 17 the Commissioner of State Lands a record containing:
- 18 <u>(1)(A) The official recording information shown by the county</u>
- 19 recorder's records and the legal description of the real property.
- 20 (B) A copy of the most recent deed to the real property
- 21 may be furnished to the Commissioner of State Lands if the copy contains the
- 22 <u>official recording information and the legal description;</u>
- 23 (2) If the real property was purchased by a state agency, the
- 24 <u>date of purchase and the purchase price; and</u>
- 25 <u>(3) The name of the state agency holding title to the real</u>

- 31 <u>(d) If a state agency does not</u> comply with the provisions of
- 32 subsection (a) of this section, the Commissioner of State Lands shall report
- 33 the failure or refusal to comply to the Governor, who shall notify the
- 34 administrative officer of the office, department, state agency, or
- 35 institution to immediately report to him or her the reasons for his or her
- 36 the state agency's failure or refusal to comply.

1	(e)(e) Willful failure or refusal to comply with this section by any		
2	officer a public official shall constitute nonfeasance in office.		
3	(f)(1) As used in this subchapter, "state agency" means an		
4	instrumentality of state government, including without limitation an office,		
5	a department, an agency, a board, a commission, or an institution of the		
6	state.		
7	(2) As used in this subchapter, "state agency" does not include:		
8	(A) The Arkansas Department of Transportation Department;		
9	(B) An institution of higher education;		
10	(C) The Arkansas Public Employees' Retirement System;		
11	(D) The Arkansas Teacher Retirement System;		
12	(E) The Arkansas State Game and Fish Commission; or		
13	(F) The Arkansas Department of Emergency Management.

15	SECTION 3. Arkansas Code Title 22, Chapter 5, Subchapter 2, is amended		
16	to add an additional section to read as follows:		
17	22-5-210. Real property records of the Arkansas Department of		
18	Transportation Department, institutions of higher education, Arkansas Public		
19	Employee's Retirement System, Arkansas Teacher Retirement System, and certain		
20	other properties.		
21	(a) With respect to real property administered by the Arkansas		
22	Department of Transportation, an institution of higher education, the		
23	Arkansas Public Employees' Retirement System, and the Arkansas Teacher		
24	Retirement System:		
25	(1) The Arkansas Department of Transportation, an institution of		
26	higher education, the Arkansas Public Employees' Retirement System, and the		
27	Arkansas Teacher Retirement System shall each maintain inventory records of		
28	the real property it owns; and		
29	(2) The commissioner of State Lands may:		
30	(A) Review, verify, and maintain inventory records of the		
31	real property; and		
32	(B) Prepare reports and make recommendations concerning		
33	the best use of the real property.		
34	(b) At the request of the Commissioner of State Lands:		
35	(1) The Arkansas Department of Transportation shall submit its		
36	real property inventory records that are not related to the roadways and		

1	bridges it maintains; and		
2	(2) No more than semiannually, the real property inventory		
3	records of an institution of higher education, the Arkansas State Game and		
4	Fish Commission, the Arkansas Public Employees' Retirement System, and the		
5	Arkansas Teacher Retirement System may be submitted to the Commissioner of		
6	State Lands for information purposes only.		
7	(c) The duties of the Commissioner of State Lands under this		
8	subchapter and § 22-5-301 et. seq. do not apply to:		
9	(1) Real property that is owned by the state but is managed by		
10	the United States Government;		
11	(2) The real property composing the State Capitol complex;		
12	(3) The real property composing the Arkansas Governor's Mansion;		
13	(4) The real property composing the state veteran's cemetery		
14	<pre>system;</pre>		
15	(5) Highway rights-of-way owned by the Arkansas Department of		
16	Transportation;		
17	(6) The real property composing the Old State House Museum;		
18	(7) The real property owned by the Arkansas Department of		
19	Emergency Management; and		
20	(8) Real property that is managed by a state retirement system		
21	as a part of its trust assets.		
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23	SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 22-5-303 is amended to read as follows:		
24	22-5-303. Additional duties of Commissioner of State Lands.		
25	${\it In}$ addition to other duties and powers conferred by law upon the		
26	Commissioner of State Lands, he or she shall have the following duties and		
27	powers:		
28	(1) To effectuate Effectuate the policies and carry out the		
29	purposes declared in § 22-5-301, to carry out its purposes including by		
30	securing the cooperation and assistance of the United States Government and		
31	any of its agencies, and $\frac{1}{1}$ and $\frac{1}{1}$ enter $\frac{1}{1}$ into contracts, agreements, and		
32	conveyances necessary to secure such federal assistance;		
33	(2) To conduct Conduct investigations, independently or jointly		
34	with other state and federal agencies, relating to conditions and factors		
35	affecting, and methods of accomplishing more effectively, the purposes of		
36	this subchapter; and		

1	(3) To assign <u>Assign</u> lands to the several state agencies for	
2	administration, subject to their agreement and acceptance; and	
3	(4) Review, compile, and maintain inventory records of the real	
4	property owned by the State of Arkansas based upon the information submitted	
5	under §§ 22-5-209 and 22-5-411 and the records in his or her office.	
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7	SECTION 5. Arkansas Code \S 22-5-305(b), concerning the membership of	
8	the State Land Use Committee, is amended to read as follows:	
9	(b) The Commissioner of State Lands shall appoint one (1) member from	
10	each of the seven (7) four (4) congressional districts and $\frac{1}{1}$ five (5)	
11	members at large for a term of two (2) years.
