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2	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code Title 14, Chapter 164, Subchapter 3, is
3	amended to add an additional section to read as follows:
4	14-164-342. Net casino gaming receipts tax bonds.
5	(a) The governing body of a municipality or county may pledge by
6	ordinance all or a specified portion of the municipality's or county's share
7	of collections of the net casino gaming receipts tax levied under The
8	Arkansas Casino Gaming Amendment of 2018, Arkansas Constitution, Amendment
9	100, to retire bonds issued for capital improvements or economic development
10	projects.
11	(b)(1) An ordinance pledging revenues under subsection (a) of this
12	section is not effective unless the issuance of the bonds is approved by a
13	majority of the electors of the municipality or county voting on the question
14	at an election that is held substantially in the manner provided under § 14-
15	164-309.
16	(2) The ballot form in an election to issue bonds secured by the
17	pledge of revenues under subsection (a) of this section shall contain a
18	statement describing the extent to which the municipality's or county's share
19	of collections of the net casino gaming receipts tax levied under The
20	Arkansas Casino Gaming Amendment of 2018, Arkansas Constitution, Amendment
21	100, may be pledged to the retirement of the bonds, if the bonds are approved
22	by the voters of the municipality or county.
23	(c) A certified copy of the ordinance authorizing the issuance of
24	bonds under this section shall be filed with the Director of the Department
25	of Finance and Administration and the Treasurer of State as soon as
26	practicable after the approval of the adoption of the ordinance under this
27	section.
28	(d)(l) If a municipality or county has filed an ordinance with the
29	Treasurer of State under subsection (c) of this section, the municipality or
30	county may elect to have its share of collections of the net casino gaming
31	receipts tax levied under The Arkansas Casino Gaming Amendment of 2018,
32	Arkansas Constitution, Amendment 100, distributed to a bank or other
33	depository designated in the ordinance adopted under this section.
34	(2)(A) If a municipality or county elects to have funds
35	distributed to a bank or other depository under subdivision (d)(l) of this
36	section, the net casino gaming receipts tax levied under The Arkansas Casino

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1	Gaming Amendment of 2018, Arkansas Constitution, Amendment 100, shall be
2	distributed to the bank or other depository designated in the ordinance
3	rather than to the municipality or county.
4	(B) The distribution under subdivision (d)(2)(A) of this
5	section shall continue until the municipality or county files a signed
6	statement with the Treasurer of State to the effect that the bonds to which
7	the net casino gaming receipts tax levied under The Arkansas Casino Gaming
8	Amendment of 2018, Arkansas Constitution, Amendment 100, are pledged have
9	been fully paid or are no longer outstanding.
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11	SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 14-164-402(2), concerning the definition of
12	"capital improvements" under the Local Government Capital Improvement Revenue
13	Bond Act of 1985, is amended to add an additional subdivision to read as
14	follows:
15	(QQ) Facilities and apparatus for voice, data, broadband,
16	video, or wireless telecommunications services.
