21	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

23	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 5-10-106 is amended to read as follows:	
24	5-10-106. Physician-assisted suicide.	
25	(a)(l) As used in this section, "physician-assisted suicide" means a	
26	physician or health care provider participating in a medical procedure or	
27	knowingly prescribing any drug, compound, or substance for the express	
28	purpose of assisting a patient to intentionally end the patient's life.	
29	(2) However, "physician-assisted suicide" does not apply to a	
30	person participating in the execution of a person sentenced by a court to	
31	death by lethal injection.	
32	(b) It is unlawful for any <u>a</u> physician or health care <u>healthcare</u>	
33	provider to commit the offense of physician-assisted suicide by:	
34	(1) Prescribing any drug, compound, or substance to a patient	
35	with the express purpose of assisting the patient to intentionally end the	
36	patient's life; or

1 (2) Assisting in any medical procedure for the express purpose 2 of assisting a patient to intentionally end the patient's life. Upon conviction, any physician or health care provider violating 3 (c) subsection (b) of this section is guilty of Physician-assisted suicide is a 4 5 Class C B felony. 6 (d) Nothing in this section prohibits This section does not prohibit 7 a: 8 (1) Physician or health care healthcare provider from carrying 9 out an advanced directive or living will; or 10 (2) Physician from prescribing any drug, compound, or substance 11 for the specific purpose of pain relief. 12 13 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code Title 5, Chapter 10, is amended to add an 14 additional section to read as follows: 15 5-10-107. Promoting a suicide attempt. 16 (a) A person commits the offense of promoting a suicide attempt if the 17 person knowingly causes or aids another person to attempt suicide. 18 (b) Promoting a suicide attempt is a Class D felony. 19 (c) It is not an offense under this section if a physician or 20 healthcare provider: 21 (1) Carries out an advance directive or living will; or 22 (2) Prescribes any drug, compound, or substance for the specific 23 purpose of pain relief. 24 25 26 27 28 29 30 31 32 33 34 35 36
