32	(c) The term of office shall commence on January 15 following the			
33	expiration date of the preceding term and shall end on January 14 of the			
34	seventh year following the year in which the term commenced.			
35	(d) Any vacancies arising in the membership of the commission for any			
36	reason other than expirat	tion of the terms for which th	e members were	

- appointed shall be filled by appointment by the Governor and be effective until the expiration of the terms, subject to the confirmation of the Senate when it is next in session.
 - (e) Before entering upon his or her duties, <u>each a</u> member of the commission shall take, subscribe, and file in the office of the Secretary of State an oath to support the United States Constitution and the Arkansas Constitution and to faithfully perform the duties of the office upon which he or she is about to enter.
 - (f) Members of the commission shall receive no pay for their services.
