State Insurance Department — Arkansas Firefighter Cancer 7 Relief Network Trust Fund - Proceeds. 8 (a)(1) The State Insurance Department shall maintain the Arkansas 9 Firefighter Cancer Relief Network Trust Fund. 10 (2)(A) The purpose of the trust fund is to fund relief for 11 firefighters who are diagnosed with cancer and participating in a firefighter 12 cancer relief network created and governed by the Arkansas Association of Fire Chiefs, the Arkansas Professional Fire Fighters Association, and the 13 Arkansas State Firefighters Association Inc. from funds donated under this 14 15 section. 16 (B) The department shall deposit any donated funds 17 received under subdivision (a)(2)(A) of this section into the fund. 18 (b) A person may donate funds to the Arkansas Firefighter Cancer 19 Relief Network Trust Fund up to an amount equal to one hundred thousand 20 dollars (\$100,000). 21 (c)(1) The Arkansas Association of Fire Chiefs, the Arkansas 22 Professional Fire Fighters Association, and the Arkansas State Firefighters 23 Association Inc. shall award relief to firefighters participating in a 24 firefighter cancer relief network beginning October 1, 2019, of up to ten 25 million dollars (\$10,000,000) per year. 26 (2) The Arkansas Association of Fire Chiefs, the Arkansas 27 Professional Fire Fighters Association, and the Arkansas State Firefighters Association Inc. shall determine eligibility and award amounts under the 28 29 rules promulgated by the department. 30 (3) The entities named under subdivision (c)(1) of this section shall return to the department any excess funding which has been donated to 31 the fund for the purpose of funding a firefighter cancer relief network. 32 (d) The department shall promulgate rules necessary to implement this 33

20	(b)(l) When adopting the initial rules to implement Section 1, Section		
21	2, and Section 3 of this act, the final rule shall be filed with the		
22	Secretary of State for adoption under § 25-15-204(f):		
23	(A) On or before January 1, 2020; or		
24	(B) If approval under § 10-3-309 has not occurred by		
25	January 1, 2020, as soon as practicable after approval under § 10-3-309.		
26	(2) The department shall file the proposed rule with the
