6	(3) An additional decal that states "combat-related death" may		
7	be placed on the Gold Star Family special license plate if the deceased		
8	service member was killed in action.		
9	(e) A Gold Star Family special license plate is not transferable as		
10	provided under § 27-24-207.		
11	(f) The registration of a Gold Star Family special license plate under		
12	this section may continue from year to year so long as it is renewed each

14	(g)(1) A family member applying for a Gold Star Family special license

11	honorable performance of his or her duty within one (1) year of receiving a		
12	service-connected injury or contracting a service-connected illness; and		
13	(A) An area of conflict recognized by the United States		
14	Department of Defense;		
15	(B) A location that entitles the deceased service member		
16	to:		
17	(i) Hardship duty pay;		
18	(ii) Hostile fire pay; or		
19	(iii) Imminent danger pay;		
20	(2) "Family member" means a spouse, parent, sibling, or child of		
21	a member of the United States Armed Forces, including without limitation:		
22	(A) A birthmother or birthfather;		
23	(B) A stepmother or stepfather;		
24	(C) An adoptive parent;
