22	(a) As used in	this section, "serious harm" means a	ny harm, whether	
23	physical or nonphysica	al, including without limitation psyc	hological,	
24	financial, or reputati	onal harm, that is sufficiently seri	ous under the	
25	circumstances to compe	el a reasonable person of the same ba	ckground and in the	
26	same circumstances as	the victim to provide or to continue	to provide labor	
27	or services to avoid i	ncurring that harm.		
28	(b) A person co	ommits child labor trafficking if he	or she has physical	
29	custody of a minor, al	lows a minor to reside in his or her	residence, is in a	
30	position of authority	over a minor, or provides care for a	ny length of time	
31	to a minor, and knowin	ngly obtains labor or services from t	the minor, benefits	
32	financially from the 1	abor or services of the minor, or re	ceives anything of	
33	value from the labor o	or services of the minor, by causing	or threatening to	
34	cause serious harm to	the minor or by engaging in a patter	n of conduct that	
35	results in:			
36	<u>(1) Physi</u>	cal injury to the minor;		

Т	(2) Sexual abuse of the minor; or		
2	(3) Sexual assault of the minor.		
3	(c) Child labor trafficking is a Class Y felony.		
4	(d) It is not a defense to prosecution that the minor consented to the		
5	performance of any labor or services.		
6	(e) It is not an offense under this section for a parent or guardian		
7	of a child to require his or her child to perform common household chores		
8	under the threat of the reasonable exercise of discipline by the parent or		
9	guardian of the child.
