14 AN ACT FOR THE ARKANSAS FAIR HOUSING
15 COMMISSION APPROPRIATION FOR THE 2019-
16 2020 FISCAL YEAR.
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20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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22 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the
23 Arkansas Fair Housing Commission for the 2019-2020 fiscal year, the following
24 maximum number of regular employees.

4 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the Arkansas
 5 Fair Housing Commission for the 2019-2020 fiscal year, the following maximum
 6 number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help",
 7 payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: two (2) temporary
 8 or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those
 9 provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its
 10 successor, or this act for the appropriate classification.
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12 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION. There is hereby appropriated, to the
 13 Arkansas Fair Housing Commission, to be payable from the Miscellaneous
 14 Agencies Fund Account, for personal services and operating expenses of the
 15 Arkansas Fair Housing Commission for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2020,

 32 SECTION 4. APPROPRIATION - EDUCATION - TRUST. There is hereby
 33 appropriated, to the Arkansas Fair Housing Commission, to be payable from the
 34 Arkansas Fair Housing Commission Trust Fund, for operating expenses of the
 35 Arkansas Fair Housing Commission for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2020,
 36 the following:

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12 SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

13 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.

14 PROMOTIONAL ITEMS. Upon approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State,

15 the Arkansas Fair Housing Commission is hereby authorized to transfer

16 appropriation from Operating Expenses to Promotional Items in the Education-

17 Trust Appropriation provided by this Act in an amount not to exceed eight

18 thousand dollars (\$8,000) each fiscal year to meet the Commission's

19 educational needs. The provisions of this section shall be in effect only

20 from July 1, ~~2018~~ 2019 through June 30, ~~2019~~ 2020.

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22 SECTION 6. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds

23 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency

24 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and

25 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and

26 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary

27 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal

28 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by

29 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be

30 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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32 SECTION 7. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General

33 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations

34 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for

35 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive

36 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget

1 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
2 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
3 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
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5 SECTION 8. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
6 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
7 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
8 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2019 is essential to the operation of
9 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
10 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
11 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2019 could work irreparable harm
12 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
13 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
14 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
15 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2019.

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
