24	This subchapter may be cited as the "Medical Corporation Act".

26	4-29-302. Definitions.

7	(A) The person in whose name shares are registered in the
8	records of a corporation; or
9	(B) The beneficial owner of shares of a revocable living
10	trust where the shares are registered in the records of the corporation in

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13	4-29-303. Application of Arkansas Business Corporation Act.
14	(a) The Arkansas Business Corporation Act of 1987, § 4-27-101 et seq.,
15	shall be applicable to such corporations, including their organization,
16	except that the required number of incorporators of a medical corporation
17	shall be one (1) or more, and they shall enjoy the powers and privileges and
18	be subject to the duties, restrictions, and liabilities of other
19	corporations, except so far as the same may be limited or enlarged by this
20	subchapter.
21	(b) If any provision of this subchapter conflicts with the Arkansas
22	Business Corporation Act of 1987, § 4-27-101 et seq., this subchapter shall
23	take precedence.
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25	4-29-304. Physician-patient relationship unaltered.
26	This subchapter does not alter any law applicable to the relationship
27	between a physician furnishing medical service and a person receiving the
28	service, including liability arising out of the service.
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30	4-29-305. Formation of corporation - Employee licensing required.
31	(a) One (1) or more persons licensed pursuant to the Arkansas Medical
32	Practices Act, § 17-95-201 et seq., § 17-95-301 et seq., and § 17-95-401 et
33	seq., may associate to form a corporation pursuant to the Arkansas Business
34	Corporation Act of 1987, § 4-27-101 et seq., to own, operate, and maintain an
35	establishment for the study, diagnosis, and treatment of human ailments and
36	injuries, whether physical or mental, and to promote medical, surgical, and

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    scientific research and knowledge.
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           (b) However, medical or surgical treatment, consultation, or advice
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    may be given by employees of the corporation only if they are licensed
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    pursuant to the Arkansas Medical Practices Act, § 17-95-201 et seq., § 17-95-

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          4-29-306. Corporate name.
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          (a)(1) The corporate name may contain the names of one (1) or more of
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     the shareholders.
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                 (2) However, the name of a person who is not employed by the
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     corporation shall not be included in the corporate name, except that the name
    of a deceased shareholder may continue to be included in the corporate name
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    for one (1) year following the decease of the shareholder.
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          (b) The corporate name shall end with the word "Chartered", or the
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    word "Limited", or the abbreviation "Ltd.", or the words "Professional
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    Association", or the abbreviation "P.A.".
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          4-29-307. Officers, directors, and shareholders.
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          (a) All of the officers, directors, and shareholders of a corporation
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    subject to this subchapter shall at all times be persons licensed pursuant to
    the Arkansas Medical Practices Act, § 17-95-201 et seq., § 17-95-301 et seq.,
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    and § 17-95-401 et seg.
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          (b) No person who is not so licensed shall have any part in the
    ownership, management, or control of the corporation, nor may any proxy to
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    vote any shares of the corporation be given to a person who is not so
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    licensed.
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          4-29-308. Employees.
          Each individual employee licensed pursuant to the Arkansas Medical
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    Practices Act, § 17-95-201 et seq., § 17-95-301 et seq., and § 17-95-401 et
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    seq., who is employed by a corporation subject to this subchapter shall
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    remain subject to reprimand or discipline for his or her conduct under the
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    provisions of the Arkansas Medical Practices Act, § 17-95-201 et seq., § 17-

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4-29-309. Certificate of registration - Issuance, renewal, etc.

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1	(a) No corporation sharr open, operate, or maritain an establishment
2	for any of the purposes set forth in § 4-29-305 without a certificate of
3	registration from the Arkansas State Medical Board.
4	(b) Application for the registration shall be made to the board in
5	writing and shall contain the name and address of the corporation and such
6	other information as may be required by the board.
7	(c)(1) Upon receipt of the application, the board shall make an
8	investigation of the corporation.
9	(2) If the board finds that the incorporators, officers,
10	directors, and shareholders are each licensed pursuant to the Arkansas
11	Medical Practices Act, § 17-95-201 et seq., § 17-95-301 et seq., and § 17-95-
12	401 et seq., and if no disciplinary action is pending before the board
13	against any of them, and if it appears that the corporation will be conducted
14	in compliance with law and the regulations of the board, the board shall
15	issue, upon payment of a registration fee of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00), a
16	certificate of registration which shall remain effective until January 1
17	following the date of the registration.
18	(d) Upon written application of the holder, accompanied by a fee of
19	ten dollars (\$10.00), the board shall annually renew the certificate of
20	registration if the board finds that the corporation has complied with its
21	regulations and the provisions of this subchapter.
22	(e) The certificate of registration shall be conspicuously posted upor
23	the premises to which it is applicable.
24	(f) In the event of a change of location of the registered
25	establishment, the board, in accordance with its regulations, shall amend the
26	certificate of registration so that it shall apply to the new location.
27	(g) No certificate of registration shall be assignable.
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29	4-29-310. Certificate of registration - Suspension or revocation.
30	(a) The Arkansas State Medical Board may suspend or revoke any
31	certificate of registration for any of the following reasons:
32	(1) The revocation or suspension of the license to practice
33	medicine of any officer, director, shareholder, or employee not promptly
34	removed or discharged by the corporation;
35	(2) Unethical professional conduct on the part of any officer,
36	director chareholder or employee not promptly removed or discharged by the

1	corporation;
2	(3) The death of the last remaining shareholder; or
3	(4) Upon finding that the holder of a certificate has failed to
4	comply with the provisions of this subchapter or the regulations prescribed
5	by the board.
6	(b)(1) Before any certificate of registration is suspended or revoked
7	the holder shall be given written notice of the proposed action and the
8	reasons therefor and shall be given a public hearing by the board with the
9	right to produce testimony concerning the charges made.
10	(2) The notice shall also state the place and date of the
11	hearing which shall be at least five (5) days after service of the notice.
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13	4-29-311. Certificate of registration - Appeal from denial,
14	suspension, or revocation.
15	(a) Any corporation whose application for a certificate of
16	registration has been denied or whose registration has been suspended or
17	revoked may appeal to the Pulaski County Circuit Court within thirty (30)
18	days after notice of the action by the Arkansas State Medical Board.
19	(b) The court shall inquire into the cause of the board's action and
20	may affirm or reverse the decision and order a further hearing by the board
21	or may order the board to grant the appellant a certificate of registration.
22	(c) Appeal shall be in the manner provided by law.
23	(d)(1) Notice of appeal shall be served upon the secretary of the
24	board by serving the secretary a copy thereof within thirty (30) days after
25	the board has notified the appellant of its decision.
26	(2) The service may be by registered or certified mail.
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28	4-29-312. Shares of deceased or disqualified shareholder - Price.
29	(a) If the articles of incorporation or bylaws of a corporation
30	subject to this subchapter fail to state a price or method of determining a
31	fixed price at which the corporation or its shareholders may purchase the
32	shares of a deceased shareholder or a shareholder no longer qualified to own
33	shares in the corporation, then the price for the shares shall be the book
34	value as of the end of the month immediately preceding the death or
35	disqualification of the shareholder.

(b) Book value shall be determined from the books and records of the

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1	corporation in accordance with the regular method of accounting used by the
2	corporation.
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4	4-29-313. Foreign medical corporations - Certificates of registration
5	- Governance - Licensure.
6	(a) If a foreign medical corporation complies with this subchapter,
7	the Arkansas State Medical Board may issue a certificate of registration to
8	the foreign medical corporation.
9	(b) A person who is not licensed to practice medicine shall not
10	participate in the ownership, management, or control of a foreign medical
11	corporation.
12	(c) A proxy to vote shares of a foreign medical corporation shall not
13	be given to a person who is not licensed to practice medicine.
14	(d) A physician who is affiliated with a foreign medical corporation
15	shall obtain a license to practice medicine from the board before practicing
16	medicine in Arkansas.
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
