22	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 28, Chapter 65, Subchapter	2, is
23	amended to add an additional section to read as follows:	
24	28-65-222. Parental appointment of temporary guardian.	
25	(a)(l) A parent of a minor child may appoint a person to a	<u>ct as a</u>
26	temporary guardian of his or her minor child in the event of the	<u>death of the</u>
27	parent if:	
28	(A)(i) The parent signs a notarized statement	<u>that</u>
29	includes:	
30	(a) The name and date of birth of	the minor
31	child for whom the person is being appointed as a temporary guard	ian; and
32	(b)(1) The name of the person who	<u>is appointed</u>
33	as the temporary guardian of the minor child.	
34	(2) A parent may appoint two	(2)
35	individuals who are married to each other as temporary co-guardia	<u>ns of a</u>
36	minor child of the parent.

1	(ii) Both parents of the minor child shall sign and	
2	otarize the written appointment of the temporary guardian if both parents of	
3	the minor child are alive; and	
4	(B) The person whom the parent appoints as a temporary	
5	guardian consents to the appointment in a signed and notarized statement.	
6	(2) A parent may revoke or amend his or her appointment of a	
7	temporary guardian under subdivision (a)(l) of this section at any time	
8	before his or her death.	
9	(b)(l) The appointment of a temporary guardian under subsection (a) of	
10	this section is immediately effective upon the:	
11	(A) Death of the appointing parent if the other parent is	
12	deceased; or	
13	(B) Death of both appointing parents.	
14	(2)(A) Upon the death of an appointing parent if the other	
15	parent is deceased or the death of both appointing parents, the appointed	
16	guardian shall have a temporary guardianship of the minor child for no more	
17	than ninety (90) days.	
18	(B) A court may extend the time period of the initial	
19	temporary guardianship for an additional ninety (90) days.	
20	(c) A person appointed as a temporary guardian under subsection (a) of	
21	this section who is interested in becoming a permanent guardian for the minor	
22	child shall follow all other procedures required under this chapter to obtain	
23	permanent guardianship of the minor child.	
24	(d) Unless otherwise provided by law, a court shall:	
25	(1) Comply with the wishes of an appointing parent; and	
26	(2) Name the person appointed as a temporary guardian by an	
27	appointing parent the permanent guardian of the minor child unless the person	
28	is determined to be unfit.
