9	(3) A letter is provided to the Legislative Council by the
10	agency stating that a rule has been filed with the Secretary of State's
11	office, the name of the rule, a brief description of the rule, and an
12	affirmative statement that the only change to the rule is a change from the
13	use of the term "regulation" to the term "rule".
14	(f) An agency may continue to follow the procedure set forth in § 25-
15	15-204 for the adoption of a rule that changes the term "regulation" to
16	<pre>"rule".</pre>
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
