20	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 12-12-312(a)(1)(A), concerning confidential			
21	and privileged records of the State Crime Laboratory, is amended to read as			
22	follows:			
23	(a)(l)(A)(i) The records, files, and information kept, obtained, or			
24	retained by the State Crime Laboratory under this subchapter are privileged			
25	and confidential.			
26		(ii) The records, files, and	information shall be	
27	released only under and by the direction of a court of competent			
28	jurisdiction, the prosecu	jurisdiction, the prosecuting attorney having criminal jurisdiction over the		
29	case, or the public defer	case, or the public defender appointed or assigned to the case <u>an attorney</u>		
30	<u>representing a person in</u>	representing a person in any capacity related to a criminal case, including		
31	without limitation an appeal, a petition for post-conviction relief, or in a			
32	parole proceeding, withou	parole proceeding, without regard to whether the person is currently a		
33	<u>defendant</u> .
