17	concerning the reassignment of judicial circuits and the reapportionment of		
18	circuit court judgeships, if necessary, to the General Assembly for		
19	consideration during the 2021 Regular Session.		
20	(b) The recommendations, if any, under this section shall be made no		
21	later than September 1, 2020, in order to be available for potential		
22	budgetary considerations during hearings of the Joint Budget Committee before		
23	the 2021 Regular Session.		
24			
25	SECTION 9. DO NOT CODIFY. Effective date.		
26	The effective date of Section 2 of this act is January 1, 2022.		
27			
28	SECTION 10. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the		
29	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that certain judicial districts		
30	under this act have an immediate need for additional circuit court judges due		
31	to the number of cases pending in the judicial district. Therefore, an		
32	emergency is declared to exist, and all Sections except Section 2 of this act		
33	being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety		
34	shall become effective on July 1, 2019.
