- 22 SECTION 15. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
- 23 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. COST OF
- 24 LIVING INCREASES AND MERIT PAY. Employees of the Arkansas Game and Fish
- 25 Commission shall be eligible for cost-of-living and merit pay adjustments at
- 26 the discretion of the Commission. In addition, the Commission is authorized
- 27 to develop and establish a merit pay system. The merit system developed by
- 28 the Commission must be reviewed by the Arkansas Legislative Council, or if
- 29 the General Assembly is in session, the Joint Budget Committee. The
- 30 Commission may establish merit payments as either an increase to an
- 31 employee's base salary or as a lump sum payment, based on sufficiency of
- 32 funding. Commission employees shall be evaluated using an instrument
- 33 developed by the Commission that incorporates performance evaluation
- 34 standards. Employees reaching the maximum rate of pay for their respective
- 35 classifications may receive merit pay or cost of living adjustments in a lump

SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 7 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 8 PROMOTIONAL ITEMS. The Arkansas State Game and Fish Commission is hereby 9 authorized to purchase from the Maintenance & General Operation 10 Classifications in the Operations Appropriation provided by this Act for 11 promotional items in an amount not to exceed fifty thousand dollars 12 (\$50,000), as authorized by the Director of the Commission to meet fish and 13 wildlife conservations and education needs. 14 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2019 15 through June 30 2020. 16 17 SECTION 17. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General 18 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 19 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for 20 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 21 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 22 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 23 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative 24 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 25 26 SECTION 18. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the 27 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits 28 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2019 is essential to the operation of 29 30 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the 31 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2019 could work irreparable harm 32
- being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health

upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental

programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
