26	government at the regular or usual place thereof, the governing body of ea	
27	political subdivision of this state may meet at any place within or withou	ιt
28	the territorial limits of the political subdivisions on the call of the	
29	presiding officer or any two (2) members of the governing body.	
30	(B) The governing body shall proceed to establish and	
31	designate by ordinance, resolution, or other manner alternate or substitut	
32	sites or places as the emergency temporary location of government where al	
33	or any part, of the public business may be transacted and conducted during	,
34 35	the emergency situation. (2) The sites or places may be within or without the territor	·ial

(b)(l) During the period when the public business is being conducted		
at an emergency temporary location, the governing body and other officers of		
a political subdivision of this state shall have and possess and shall		
exercise at the location all of the executive, legislative, and judicial		
powers and functions conferred upon the governing body and officers by or		
under the laws of this state.		

- (2) The powers and functions of the governing body and officers may be exercised without regard to or compliance with time-consuming procedures and formalities prescribed by law and pertaining thereto. All acts of the governing body and officers shall be as valid and binding as if performed within the territorial limits of their political subdivision.
- (c) "Political subdivisions" shall mean As used in this section,
 "political subdivisions" means all duly formed and constituted governing
 bodies created and established under authority of the Arkansas Constitution
 and laws of this state.
