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21	WHEREAS, hazard mitigation is the effort to reduce the loss of life and
22	property by lessening the impact of disasters, and it is most effective when
23	implemented under a comprehensive long-term mitigation plan; and
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25	WHEREAS, the Pre-Disaster Mitigation Grant Program administered by the
26	Federal Emergency Management Agency is designed to assist states and local
27	communities in implementing a sustained pre-disaster natural hazard
28	mitigation program; and
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30	WHEREAS, the federal Disaster Recovery Reform Act of 2018 makes
31	available new funding for states and communities to undertake pre-disaster
32	mitigation measures; and
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34	WHEREAS, since 1908 natural disasters have cost the country more than
35	\$1,000,000,000; and
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1 WHEREAS, disasters affect local and state economies in lost payrolls, 2 lost sales, income taxes, and increased disaster recovery times; and 3 4 WHEREAS, according to a study commissioned by the Federal Emergency 5 Management Agency and conducted by the National Institute of Building 6 Sciences, every \$1 spent on hazard mitigation provides the nation with \$6 in 7 future benefits; and 8 9 WHEREAS, 25% of small businesses impacted by a natural disaster never 10 reopen their doors; and 11 12 WHEREAS, in recognition of the need for all Americans to prepare and plan for recovery, September is "National Preparedness Month" in the United 13 14 States; and 15 16 WHEREAS, mitigation planning is a key process used to break the cycle 17 of disaster damage, reconstruction, and repeated damage; and 18 19 WHEREAS, effective pre-disaster mitigation reduces the demand for 20 relief services on volunteer organizations, food banks, and homeless shelters 21 that serve our communities by changing their operations to provide additional 22 services to those affected by disaster; and 23 24 WHEREAS, it is our honorable and brave citizens who act as first 25 responders and selflessly provide aid to safeguard other citizens; and 26 27 WHEREAS, it is important that communities develop long-term mitigation 28 strategies to protect people and property from future disasters, 29 30 NOW THEREFORE, 31 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE NINETY-SECOND GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE 32 STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN: 33 34 THAT the Senate declares the first week of September 2019 to be "Resiliency Week" to raise public awareness of the need for disaster 35 36 mitigation strategies.

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
