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19	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF	ARKANSAS:
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21	SECTION 1. REAPPROPRIATION - ADE - DESE - DEVELO	OPMENT AND ENHANCEMENT.
22	There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Education, to be payable	
23	from the Development and Enhancement Fund, for the Department of Education -	
24	Division of Elementary and Secondary Education the fol	llowing:
25	(A) Effective July 1, 2020, the balance of the	appropriation provided
26	in Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 230 of 2019, for compu	ter science initiatives
27	by the Department of Education, in a sum not to exceed	1\$948,416.
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29	SECTION 2. REAPPROPRIATION - ADE - DESE - CAPITO	OL COMPLEX RENOVATION
30	AND REPAIR. There is hereby appropriated, to the Depa	artment of Education, to
31	be payable from the Educational Buildings Maintenance	Fund, for the
32	Department of Education - Division of Elementary and Secondary Education the	
33	following:	
34	(A) Effective July 1, 2020, the balance of the	appropriation provided
35	in Item (A) of Section 2 of Act 230 of 2019, for finan	ncing for building and
36	grounds maintenance, equipment maintenance contracts,	insurance and



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1 janitorial services, major maintenance costs, renovation, improvements, 2 repairs and operations to maintain four (4) buildings owned by the Department 3 of Education located in the Capitol Complex, in a sum not to exceed 4\$3,119,890. (B) Effective July 1, 2020, the balance of the appropriation provided 5 6 in Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 349 of 2019, for financing for building and 7 grounds maintenance, equipment maintenance contracts, insurance and 8 janitorial services, major maintenance costs, renovation, improvements, 9 repairs and operations to maintain four (4) buildings owned by the Department 10 of Education located in the Capitol Complex, in a sum not to exceed 11\$5,000,000. 12 13 SECTION 3. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor 14 obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects 15 described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available 16 therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and 17 agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and

donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act.

(B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of this State and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of any funds provided by this act unless specifically provided otherwise by law.

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33 SECTION 4. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General 34 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 35 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for 36 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive

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1	Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget	
2	manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or	
3	summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative	
4	Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.	
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6	SECTION 5. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General	
7	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the	
8	appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the	
9	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2020 is essential to the operation of	
10	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in	
11	the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the	
12	effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2020 could work irreparable harm	
13	upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental	
14	programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act	
15	being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health	
16	and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2020.	
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
