22	SECTION 1. REAPP	ROPRIATION - BOONEVILLE HUMAN DEV	ELOPMENT CENTER.
23	There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Human Services, to be		
24	payable from the federal funds as designated by the Chief Fiscal Officer of		
25	the State, for the Dep	artment of Human Services - Divis	ion of Developmental

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34	SECTION 2. REAPP	ROPRIATION - DIVISION OF DEVELOPM	ENTAL DISABILITIES
35	SERVICES - FEDERAL. T	here is hereby appropriated, to t	he Department of Human
36	Services, to be payabl	e from the federal funds as design	nated by the Chief

- Fiscal Officer of the State, for the Department of Human Services Division of Developmental Disabilities Services the following:
- - (B) Effective July 1, 2020, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (B) of Section 1 of Act 401 of 2019, for implementation of the residential housing plan of the Booneville Human Development Center master plan including costs associated with demolition, construction, replacement, renovation, upgrade, and addition of facilities at the Booneville Human Development Center, in a sum not to exceed\$8,482,600.

- SERVICES. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Human Services, to be payable from the Development and Enhancement Fund, for the Department of Human Services Division of Developmental Disabilities Services the following:
- (A) Effective July 1, 2020, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (A) of Section 2 of Act 401 of 2019, for costs associated with construction, renovation, replacement, upgrade, improvement, addition, and modernization of facilities and equipment for the infirmary at the Conway Human Development Center, in a sum not to exceed\$1,712,800.
- (B) Effective July 1, 2020, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (B) of Section 2 of Act 401 of 2019, for costs associated with construction, renovation, replacement, upgrade, improvement, and addition of facilities and equipment for an eight bed crisis residence at the Jonesboro Human Development Center, in a sum not to exceed\$1,010,000.

SECTION 4. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and

- donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or
- 2 funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State
- 3 Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects
- 4 enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds
- 5 otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General
- 6 Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall
- 7 not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act.
- 8 (B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State
- 9 Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the
- 10 Revenue Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of
- 11 this State and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and
- 12 Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in
- 13 disbursement of any funds provided by this act unless specifically provided
- 14 otherwise by law.

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16 SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General

17 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations

contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for

which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive

20 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget

21 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or

22 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative

23 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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25 SECTION 6. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General

26 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the

27 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the

effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2020 is essential to the operation of

- 29 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
- 30 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
- 31 <u>effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2020 could work irreparable harm</u>
- 32 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
- 33 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
- 34 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
- and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2020.

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
