31	effec	tive date of this Act beyond July 1, 2020 could work irr	eparable harm
32	upon	the proper administration and provision of essential gov	<u>ernmental</u>
33	progr	ams. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist	and this Act
34	being	necessary for the immediate preservation of the public	peace, health
35	and s	afety shall be in full force and effect from and after J	uly 1, 2020.
