19 SECTION 5. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds 20 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency 21 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and 22 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 23 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 24 Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditures 25 Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this 26 State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of 27 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied 28 with in disbursement of said funds.

| 3 | SECTION 7. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General |
| 4 | Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the |
| 5 | appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the |
| 6 | effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2020 is essential to the operation of |
