28	SECTION 7. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determine	d by the General
29	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas proh	ibits the
30	appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; t	hat the
31	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2020 is essential to the	operation of
32	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provi	ded, and that in
33	the event of an extension of the legislative session, the del	ay in the
34	effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2020 could work irr	
35	upon the proper administration and provision of essential gov	<u>ernmental</u>
36	programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist	and this Act
