35	CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY	
36	COMPREHENSIVE SYSTEM OF PERSONNEL DEVELOPMENT. Section 101(a)	)(7) of the

- 1 Rehabilitation Act Amendments of 1992, commonly referred to as the
- 2 Comprehensive System of Personnel Development (CSPD), requires State
- 3 Vocational Rehabilitation (VR) agencies to establish qualified personnel
- 4 standards for rehabilitation personnel, including VR counselors, that are
- 5 consistent with any national or State-approved or recognized certification,
- 6 licensing, or registration that apply to a particular profession. In order to
- 7 comply with the Rehabilitation Act and its State Plan requirements, there is
- 8 hereby authorized for the Arkansas Rehabilitation Services a general waiver
- 9 of the Financial Management Guide, R1-19-4-522 Continuing Professional
- 10 Education. This waiver allows the agency to provide college level coursework
- 11 in degree programs for any eligible employees selected by the agency. This
- 12 provision covers any and all formula and discretionary grants funded by the
- 13 U.S.D.O.E. Rehabilitation Services Administration, now or in the future,
- 14 including, but not limited to, the Vocational Rehabilitation Program,
- 15 Supported Employment, Independent Living, and the Staff Development Grant.
- 16 The waiver applies to federal financial participation (FFP), state general
- 17 revenue share, and program income.
- The provisions of this section shall be in effect from July 1, 2019 2020
- 19 through June 30, 2020 2021.

- 21 SECTION 10. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
- 22 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.
- 23 FORGIVENESS OF STUDENT LOAN PROGRAM. The Forgiveness of Student Loan Program
- 24 shall be available to counselors employed by Arkansas Rehabilitation Services
- 25 that have been determined eligible by rules promulgated by Arkansas
- 26 Rehabilitation Services as required by Arkansas Code §25-30-206. These rules
- 27 shall be submitted to the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget
- 28 Committee under § 10-3-309 and receive review and approval. These rules must
- 29 include the following eligibility requirements:
- 30 (1) Satisfactory completion of any probationary period;
- 31 (2) Proof of a student loan that remains unpaid, including the name and 32 address of the creditor;
- 33 (3) An executed employment contract in which the counselor agrees to 34 the following:
- 35 (a) work for Arkansas Rehabilitation Services for a term that equals
- 36 two (2) years for each year that the program makes a payment on the

- 1 counselor's student loan and
- 2 (b) reimburse the program the full amount of any loan payments made
- 3 under this program in the event that the counselor resigns or is terminated
- 4 for cause before the term of the contract terminates.
- 5 The amount of payment to be made directly to the counselor's student
- 6 loan creditor may not exceed:
- 7 (1) Two thousand dollars (\$2,000) per year; or
- 8 (2) Ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) per employee.
- 9 The Arkansas Rehabilitation Services agency shall pay for the
- 10 Forgiveness of Student Loan Program from the Rehabilitation Program Grants -
- 11 Grants and Aid line item authorized for the appropriation entitled
- 12 Rehabilitation Services Operations in an amount not to exceed eighty
- 13 thousand dollars (\$80,000) per fiscal year.
- 14 In addition, the Arkansas Rehabilitation Services agency shall provide a
- 15 formal, written notification to all counselors employed by Arkansas
- 16 Rehabilitation Services of the availability of the Forgiveness of Student
- 17 Loan Program by July 1 of each fiscal year. The agency shall include with the

- 29 SECTION 11. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds

- 32 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
- 33 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary

3	SECTION 12. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
4	Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
5	contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
6	which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
7	Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
8	manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
9	summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
10	Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
11	
12	SECTION 13. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
13	General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits
14	the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
15	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2020 is essential to the operation of
16	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
17	the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
18	effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2020 could work irreparable harm
19	upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
20	programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
21	being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
22	and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2020.
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
