 34 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. EXTRA
 35 HELP. No employee of the Camp J.T. Robinson, or Fort Chaffee Federal
 36 Training Site Divisions of the Military Department who is employed as "extra

1 help” may receive an amount to exceed eighty-five percent (85%) of the
2 maximum annual salary for a comparable position as authorized under Arkansas
3 Code 21-5-201 et seq. during any fiscal year, nor shall such employee be
4 employed for a period of time to exceed eighteen hundred (1800) hours in any
5 single fiscal year.

11 ROBINSON - VARIOUS STATE MILITARY LAKES. The State Military Department is
12 hereby authorized to stock various State Military Lakes on Camp Robinson post
13 each year with fish for special events by using wildlife funds and rental
14 income, no State General Revenue will be used.

19 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. GENERALS
20 SALARY. The line item maximums for the State of Arkansas Adjutant General and
21 Deputy Adjutant General are based on the salary grid by the United States
22 Department of Defense. Incumbents in these positions shall be compensated in
23 accordance with the Department of Defense Advisory Service Pay Plan and are
24 not guaranteed placement at the maximum level. The line item maximum
25 salaries may be adjusted on July 1 of each fiscal year to incorporate salary
26 rate changes that have been implemented by the U.S. Department of Defense.

27 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2019~~
28 2020 through June 30, ~~2020~~ 2021.

29
30 SECTION 19. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
31 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.
32 PROMOTIONAL ITEMS. The State Military Department is hereby authorized to
33 transfer appropriation from Operating Expenses to Promotional Items in the
34 General Operations Appropriation and/or Cash Operations Appropriation
35 provided by this Act in an amount not to exceed ten thousand dollars
36 (\$10,000) each fiscal year, as authorized by the Director of State Resources,

1 and with the approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State.

2 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2019~~
3 2020 through June 30, ~~2020~~ 2021.

4
5 SECTION 20. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE
6 ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.
7 CARRY FORWARD OF FUNDS.

8 (a) The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall cause to be transferred
9 on his or her books and those of the State Treasurer and Auditor of State the
10 balance of funds remaining in the Department of Military Fund Account on June
11 30, ~~2020~~ 2021 into a sub-fund created within the Department of Military Fund
12 to be used exclusively for construction, maintenance and operating expenses
13 or for future construction projects of the State Military Department.

14 (b) Any carry forward of unexpended balance of funding as authorized
15 herein, may be carried forward under the following conditions:

16 (1) The Office of Budget of the Department of Finance and
17 Administration shall report to the Legislative Council all amounts carried
18 forward by the September meeting of the Legislative Council or the Joint
19 Budget Committee meeting which report shall include the name of the agency,
20 board, commission, or institution and the amount of funding carried forward,
21 the program name or line item and the funding source; and

22 (2) The State Military Department shall provide a written report
23 to the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee containing all
24 information set forth in subdivision (b)(1) of this section no later than
25 thirty (30) days prior to the time the Department presents its budget request
26 to the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee, or both; and

27 (3) Thereupon, the Department of Finance and Administration shall
28 include all information obtained in subdivision (b)(2) of this section in the
29 budget manuals.

30 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July
31 1, ~~2019~~ 2020 through June 30, ~~2020~~ 2021.

33 SECTION 21. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
34 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
35 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
36 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and

1 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
2 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
3 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
4 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
5 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

6
7 SECTION 22. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
8 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
9 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
10 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
11 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
12 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
13 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
14 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

15
16 SECTION 23. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
17 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits
18 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
19 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2020 is essential to the operation of
20 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
21 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
22 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2020 could work irreparable harm
23 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
24 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
25 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
26 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2020.
