- 30 SECTION 19. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
- 31 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CARRY
- 32 FORWARD OF FUNDS.
- 33 (a) Except as authorized in subsection (c) of this section, the
- 34 Department of Health is authorized to carry forward any unspent funds
- 35 remaining in the Public Health Fund on June 30, 2020 2021 allocated for the
- 36 support of the Trauma System to be used for the same purposes in the next

- l fiscal year.
- 2 (b) Any carry forward of unexpended balance of funding as authorized 3 herein, may be carried forward under the following conditions:
- 4 (1) Prior to June 30, 2020 2021, the agency shall by written 5 statement set forth its reason(s) for the need to carry forward said funding 6 to the Office of Budget of the Department of Finance and Administration;
- 7 (2) The Office of Budget of the Department of Finance and 8 Administration shall report to the Legislative Council all amounts carried
- 9 forward by the September meeting of the Legislative Council or the Joint
- 10 Budget Committee meeting which report shall include the name of the agency,
- 11 board, commission, or institution and the amount of funding carried forward,
- 12 the program name or line item, the funding source and a copy of the written

- 18 WORKS AND ARKANSAS HEALTH INSURANCE MARKETPLACE RESTRICTIONS. (a) As used in

- 20 Arkansas Works Act of 2016, Arkansas Code § 23-61-1001 et seq.
- 21 (b)(1) Determining the maximum number of employees, the maximum amount
- 22 of appropriation, for what purposes an appropriation is authorized, and
- 23 general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year is the
- 24 prerogative of the General Assembly.
- 25 (2) The purposes of subdivision (b)(1) of this section are
- 26 typically accomplished by:

- 28 (B) Delineating such maximums in the appropriation act for

- 10 producers under the Arkansas Health Insurance Marketplace Navigator, Guide,
- 11 and Certified Application Counselors Act, Arkansas Code § 23-64-601 et seq.
- 12 (2) Subdivision (e)(1) of this section does not apply to
- 13 certified application counselors at health related institutions, including
- 14 without limitation the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences.
- 15 (f) An appropriation authorized by the General Assembly shall not be

- 27 SECTION 22. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

- 29 SERVICES. (a)(1)(A) The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State may create paying
- 30 accounts on his or her books and on the books of the Treasurer of State and
- 31 the Auditor of State for the payment of personal services and operating
- 32 <u>expenses by the Department of Health.</u>
- 33 (B) Upon prior approval of the Arkansas Legislative Council, or

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25 SECTION 23. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds

26 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency

- and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
- 28 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
- 29 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
- 30 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
- 31 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
- 32 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
- 33 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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35 SECTION 24. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General

36 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations

1	contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
2	which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
3	Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
4	manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
5	summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
6	Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
7	
8	SECTION 25. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
9	General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits
10	the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
11	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2020 is essential to the operation of
12	the agency for which the appropriations in this $\mbox{Act}$ are provided, and that in
13	the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
14	effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2020 could work irreparable harm
15	upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
16	programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
17	being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
18	and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2020.
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
