- 3 allocated for community-based services under the appropriation for (i) the
- 4 Grants-in-Aid appropriation in this act, (ii) the Grants/Patient Services
- 5 Line in the Operations appropriation in this act, and (iii) the Inter-

- 30 harvested from land owned by the Division of Developmental Disabilities
- 31 Services. All funds deposited and all expenses shall be tracked separately.
- 32 The harvesting of timber is specifically authorized to provide funds to
- 33 finance capital improvements to the physical plants and for the purchase of
- 34 major capital equipment.
- 35 The Division of Developmental Disabilities Services shall report all
- 36 income derived from timber management to the Chief Fiscal Officer of the

- 1 State and the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee. Any
- 2 contracts initiated for the harvesting of timber shall be submitted to the
- 3 Review Subcommittee of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget
- 4 Committee for prior review. All expenditures of funds derived from the sale
- 5 of timber will be expended in accordance with relevant state purchasing laws.
- The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, <del>2019</del> 2020 through June 30, <del>2020</del> 2021.

- 9 SECTION 14. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 10 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. HUMAN 11 DEVELOPMENT CENTERS AND COMMUNITY PROVIDERS.
- 12 (A) The Developmental Disabilities Services Board or the Department of
  13 Human Services shall not close any of the state administered Human
  14 Development Centers which are located at Conway, Arkadelphia, Jonesboro,
  15 Booneville, and Warren.
- (B) The Department of Human Services shall continue to accept clients for whom it has determined that therapy and residential services are needed at state administered Human Development Centers and Community Programs licensed by DDS shall continue to accept clients for whom it has been determined in accordance with federal law that are in need of services in the community.
- 21 (C) Except for use as federal matching funds, no funds for community based 22 services licensed by DDS shall be transferred from Grants to Community 23 Providers line item of the Developmental Disabilities Services - Grants-in-24 Aid appropriation unless the transfer(s) directly benefit(s) community based 25 services for persons with developmental disabilities or from the 26 appropriation for the Human Development Centers unless the transfer(s) 27 directly benefit(s) the Human Development Centers.
- (D) Nor shall any general revenue funding as of July 1, 2019 2020 from the 28 29 Grants to Community Providers line item of the Developmental Disabilities Services - Grants-in-Aid appropriation for persons with developmental 30 31 disabilities or from any other general revenues as of July 1, 2019 2020, 32 applied as federal matching funds for community based services licensed by DDS on July 1, 2019 2020 be reduced below the approved funding level on July 33 1, 2019 2020; nor shall the general revenues applied as federal matching 34 35 funds for the Human Development Centers be reduced below the approved funding
- 36 level on July 1, 2019 2020.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,  $\frac{2019}{2020}$  through June 30,  $\frac{2020}{2021}$ .

4 SECTION 15. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 5 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.

6 ELIMINATION OF AUTISM WAIVER SERVICES WAITING LIST. Immediately upon the

effective date of this Act, the Department of Human Services - Division of

8 Developmental Disabilities Services shall budget, allocate, and expend up to

9 one million dollars (\$1,000,000) for the elimination of the Autism Waiver

10 Services Program waiting list.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,  $\frac{2019}{2020}$  2020 through June 30,  $\frac{2020}{2021}$  2021.

SECTION 16. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

SECTION 17. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

SECTION 18. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2020 is essential to the operation of

1	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
2	the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
3	effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2020 could work irreparable harm
4	upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
5	programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
6	being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
7	and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2020.
