33	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE NINETY-SECOND GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE	
34	STATE OF ARKANSAS:

36	(a) THAT the Fiscal Session of the Ninety-Second General Assembly	of

1 the State of Arkansas is extended until 12:00 noon, May 22, 2020;

(b) THAT the Fiscal Session of the Ninety-Second General Assembly of
the State of Arkansas shall enter into recess at a time as may be agreed upon
by the House of Representatives and the Senate;

5 THAT under Arkansas Constitution, Article 6, § 15, before (c) 6 adjournment of the General Assembly, the Governor is afforded five (5) days 7 after receipt of a bill to sign a bill or veto a bill; therefore, the House 8 of Representatives and the Senate shall be open on regular business days 9 through 12:00 noon, May 22, 2020 so that the office of the Chief Clerk of the 10 House of Representatives and the office of the Secretary of the Senate may 11 receive communications, vetoes of bills by the Governor, and notification of 12 errors and oversights;

13 (d) THAT the Speaker of the House of Representatives and the President14 Pro Tempore of the Senate may, by joint proclamation:

15 (1) Reconvene the General Assembly at any time before 12:00 16 noon, May 22, 2020; or

17 (2) Adjourn the Fiscal Session of the Ninety-Second General
18 Assembly at any time before 12:00 noon, May 22, 2020, if they determine it is
19 not necessary to reconvene;

(e) THAT if the General Assembly is not reconvened or adjourned before
12:00 noon, May 22, 2020, the Fiscal Session of the Ninety-Second General
Assembly is adjourned sine die on that date;

(f) THAT during the Fiscal Session of the Ninety-Second General
Assembly, in addition to the recess provided for in subdivision (b) of this
section, the:

(1) House of Representatives may recess for periods of four (4)
consecutive days or longer, by declaration of the Speaker of the House of
Representatives; and

29 (2) Senate may recess for periods of four (4) consecutive days
30 or longer, by declaration of the President Pro Tempore of the Senate; and

(g) THAT during the Fiscal Session of the Ninety-Second General Assembly, the House of Representatives, in order to follow recommended guidelines for social distancing and protection of members, staff, and guests during the COVID-19 public health emergency, is authorized to convene and adjourn as necessary outside the State Capitol Building at the Jack Stephens Center on the campus of the University of Arkansas at Little Rock, or at such
