- 5 and the reader, when necessary, shall be present throughout jury service, the
- 6 trial, and when the jury assembles for deliberation.
- 7 (b)(1) Whenever a sign language interpreter, real-time captioning, or
- 8 a reader is utilized in judicial proceedings or in jury deliberations, the
- 9 court will administer an oath to the interpreter, the person writing the
- 10 real-time captioning, and the reader, to ensure objective and unbiased
- 11 translation and complete confidentiality of the proceedings.
