15	TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING WHEN LIGHTED	
16	LAMPS ARE REQUIRED ON CERTAIN TYPES OF	
17	VEHICLES AND VESSELS.

20	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:	
21		
22	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 22-4-113(c), concerning the use of cert	ain
23	vehicles by a person who has a disability document and a valid driver's	
24	license, is amended to read as follows:	
25	(c) An all-terrain vehicle or golf cart that is operated between t	<u>he</u>
26	time from one-half (1/2) hour after sunset and one-half (1/2) hour before to	
27	sunrise or any other time when there is insufficient light to render clea	rly
28	discernible persons at a distance of five hundred feet (500') shall have	
29	proper lights on the all-terrain vehicle or golf cart.	
30		
31	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 27-21-106(a)(2)(B), concerning the unla	
32	operation of an all-terrain vehicle on a public street or highway, is ame	nded
33	to read as follows:	
34	(B)(i) An all-terrain vehicle may cross a divided high	-
35	only at an intersection of the highway with another public street or high	-
36	(ii) In crossings made between the hours <u>time</u> fr	om

1 one-half $(\frac{1}{2})$ hour after sunset to one-half $(\frac{1}{2})$ hour before sunrise or in 2 conditions of reduced visibility, the crossing may be made only with both front and rear lights turned on; 3 4 SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 27-21-107(b)(2), concerning the operation 5 6 of an all-terrain vehicle by a minor, is amended to read as follows: 7 (2) During Between the hours time from one half (1/2) hour after 8 sunset to one-half (1/2) hour before sunrise without displaying a lighted 9 headlight and a lighted taillight. 10 11 SECTION 4. Arkansas Code §27-36-204(a)(1), concerning times when 12 lighted lamps are required, is amended to read as follows: 13 (a)(1) Every vehicle, except motorcycles and motor-driven cycles, upon 14 a highway within this state at any between the time from one half (1/2) hour 15 after sunset to one-half (1/2) hour before sunrise and at any other time when 16 there is not sufficient light to render clearly discernible persons and 17 vehicles on the highway at a distance of five hundred feet (500') ahead shall display lighted lamps and illuminating devices as respectively required for 18 19 different classes of vehicles, subject to exceptions with respect to parked 20 vehicles as stated. 21 22 SECTION 5. Arkansas Code § 27-37-205(a), concerning vehicles required 23 to carry flares or other warning devices, is amended to read as follows: 24 No person shall operate any motor truck, passenger bus, truck 25 tractor, or any motor vehicle towing a house trailer upon any highway outside 26 the corporate limits of municipalities at any between the time from one-half $(\frac{1}{2})$ hour after sunset to one-half $(\frac{1}{2})$ hour before sunrise unless there shall 27 28 be carried in the vehicle the following equipment except as provided in 29 subsection (b) of this section: 30 (1)(A) At least three (3) flares, three (3) red electric 31 lanterns, or three (3) portable red emergency reflectors, each of which shall 32 be capable of being seen and distinguished at a distance of not less than six 33 hundred feet (600') under normal atmospheric conditions at nighttime;. 34 (B)(i) No flare, fuse, electric lantern, or cloth warning 35 flag shall be used for the purpose of compliance with the requirements of 36 this subsection unless the equipment is of a type which that has been

1	submitted to the commissioner <u>Secretary of the Department of Finance and</u>
2	Administration and approved by him or her; and.
3	(ii) No portable reflector unit shall be used for
4	the purpose of compliance with the requirements of this subsection unless it
5	is so designed and constructed as to be capable of reflecting red light
6	clearly visible from all distances within six hundred feet (600') to one
7	hundred feet (100') under normal atmospheric conditions at night when
8	directly in front of lawful upper beams of headlamps and unless it is of a
9	type which that has been submitted to the commissioner secretary and approved
10	by him or her;
11	(2) At least three (3) red-burning fusees, unless red electric
12	lanterns or red portable emergency reflectors are carried; and
13	(3) At least two (2) red cloth flags, not less than twelve
14	inches (12") square, with standards to support the flags.
15	
16	SECTION 6. Arkansas Code § 27-101-202(6), concerning restrictions on
17	operating a motorboat or vessel, is amended to read as follows:
18	(6) Shall operate a vessel on any waters of this state towing a
19	person on water skis, or an aquaplane or similar device, nor shall any person
20	engage in water skiing, aquaplaning, or similar activity at any time between
21	the $\frac{\text{hours}}{\text{time}}$ from $\frac{\text{one-half}}{\text{one-half}}$ from $\frac{1}{2}$ hour after sunset to $\frac{\text{one-half}}{\text{one-half}}$ hour
22	before sunrise. However, the provisions of this subdivision (6) do not apply
23	to night water skiing or aquaplaning on controlled areas designated for those
24	purposes where adequate lighting is provided;
