23	SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determine	ed by the General	
24	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas pro-	<u>hibits the</u>	
25	appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period;	that the	
26	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2021 is essential to the	e operation of	
27	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are prov	ided, and that in	
28	the event of an extension of the legislative session, the de	<u>lay in the</u>	
29	effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2021 could work ir	reparable harm	
30	upon the proper administration and provision of essential go	<u>vernmental</u>	
31	programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act		
32	being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public	peace, health	
33	and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after	July 1, 2021.	
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
